Varsity Overview

Continuing tradition in Edwardsville Wrestling is no easy feat. The 2007-08 Tiger Wrestling Team challenged themselves to reach the accomplishments of past Tigers. Many EHS Wrestlers put in numerous hours of off-season wrestling, and weight training from March – November.

This year's hard work and effort propelled the Tigers to roll through the Southwest Conference duals untouched, claiming their third title in as many years. The key ingredient to this year's success came with depth. As like happens in most seasons, injuries can pile up through the course of a season. Every time someone had to sit out, there was another guy ready to be fired up. This has been a cornerstone for the past few years, enabling us to win 25 conference duals in a row. The Tigers were crowned Mascoutah Champions for a record 5th straight year and finished a mere 1 point out of second place at a very solid field at the Granite City Holiday Tournament. Another outstanding accomplishment was placing second at the Fox Duals, defeating the previous year's 4A runner-up – Fort Zumwalt West, and losing a close battle against 3A State Champs, Wentzville Holt. Although placing 12th at the "Cheesehead, many outstanding performances were shown, led by Daryl Thomas' 125lb Championship and Lance Fisters' runner-up finish. We came just short of a regional championship, but scorched the competition at sectionals, qualifying 6 wrestlers for the Individual State Tournament. (Daryl Thomas, Greg Jackson, Quincy Jackstadt, Lance Fister, Ben Treat, and Zac Gaudreault) If team points were scored like they used to be at the sectional, the Tigers would have won by about 50 points. Although the 6 individuals participating in the state meet fell a bit short of their goals, they all wrestled and competed very hard. Although having come short of bringing hardware home, having 3 wrestlers place in the top 8 for Edwardsville is a first.

This year marked the year of the Senior, as we had 15 seniors finish the season. Although not all of them represented by being a starter, they all represented their school, team, and parents well, and helped contribute to their teammate's success. Daryl Thomas led the team in his usual quiet but effective style. Ben Treat continued his varsity success for the 4th season in a row. Lance Fister came into his own, and showed everyone in the area what a "whizzer" really is. Zac Gaudreault improved to be one of the best 189lb's in the area. Trent Buckingham became the best utility man in wrestling (9-0). Jared Sawyer contributed another successful season, with his "unique" style of wrestling. All of the Seniors were enjoyable to be around, and seemingly enjoyed the bond that they shared with each other. Having 15 Seniors is unique to the sport of wrestling, and a record that I am very proud of. There have undoubtedly been many friendships made throughout their wrestling career, and special moments that will never be forgotten. **"Remember the Journey"** as all of the ups and downs are all learning experiences that may help you in your future endeavors. It's been a great ride, please **"Remember the Journey"** and that once a **Tiger Wrestler, always a Tiger Wrestler.**

With such a larger Senior group, filling the holes left by them will be a tremendous task. Although we are losing 4 state qualifiers and a bunch of letterman, the talent that remains in the Tiger Wrestling room is enough to provide another year of excitement. This can only be accomplished by hard work and dedication that past Tiger Wrestlers have endured. We need to continue to work hard, and remember what got us to win 3 conference championships. The off-season starts soon, and if not out for another sport spring/summer wrestling and weightlifting should be attended. Underclassmen, let's shoot our goals for surpassing this year's accomplishments. Let's reach what some think is unreachable.

Seniors, thanks again for the effort and memories that we all share. Coaches – thanks for being the best staff around and putting up with me. Middle school coaches and EWC coaches, thanks for providing me with the wealth of talent that you do each year, making my job a lot easier. Thanks parents and Booster Club members for enabling my vision for our program to become real and supporting me, Edwardsville Wrestling, and your son. Edwardsville Wrestling is the culmination of many working toward one goal – success, fun, and a memorable journey. I hope through wrestling we have developed young boys to become great men, ready to take a challenge of life's responsibilities and hardships.

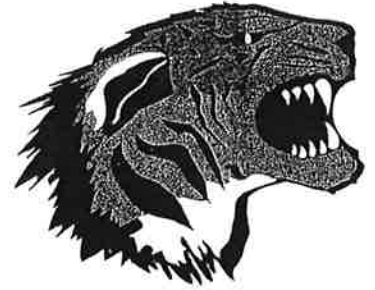
