Each year, the I.S.W.A. sponsors the "John Hurrel Memorial Award", named in his honor. This award will be presented at the 2022 Indiana High School Wrestling Coaches Association Banquet in February 2022 (more info tba) to an individual who has made an "Outstanding Contribution" to the sport of Amateur Wrestling in the State of Indiana. This may be either an adult volunteer or coach. John Hurrel, one of the original founders of the Indiana State Wrestling Association, coached for many years at Arsenal Technical High School in Indianapolis. John was devoted to wrestling and to the kids in Indiana.

John's motto was "DO IT FOR THE KIDS!"

John served on the ISWA Board of Directors from 1978 until his passing in 1991. The "John Hurrel Memorial Award" was established shortly after his death in honor of his many years of service.

Attention all Wrestlers/Wrestling Leader Members Note Information Below:

1. All clubs are required to have a current USAW Wrestling Leadership membership to expedite the charter. Please allow ample time to complete this process.
2. Coaches & Officials— are now called USAW Wrestling Leaders and are required for renewal to complete the SAFE SPORT certification which is a FREE course provided by www.teamusa.com. Coaches and officials will create an account and add the certification to their shopping cart. A 90 minute tutorial video with short quizzes will allow coaches and officials to be more informed across the nation of the most up to date expectations of SAFE SPORT. This certification for our coaches and officials organizations will allow our wrestling community to be a safer and more informed organization of responsible individuals. Thank you for your cooperation in completing this at your earliest convenience. Please allow 24 hours for the SAFE SPORT certification to be added to your USAW profile. The background check will remain effective as before, required every two years through NCSI. More information is available on the Coaches tab on www.iswa.com. Including a phone numbers and links to the appropriate requirements.
3. Athletes—Please note that USAW now requires an all members to CREATE A FREE ACCOUNT. Please note USAW requires account to be created by someone 18 years or older. Parents purchasing memberships for the first time will need to create an account and then create an account for their athlete. Returning parents will need to also create a free account and then CLAIM the old profile with athlete NAME and DATE OF BIRTH or former USAW ID.

Athletes 17 yrs and older are ALSO now required to complete the SAFE SPORT certification
