## GENERAL USE

Rink C is a shared, multi-use space designated for team practices, small group training, private lessons, goalie clinics, Learn to Skate, and individual skill development.

Use of Rink C is a **member benefit** and is restricted to skaters affiliated with one of the following organizations who is either registered to participate in one of the following programs for the 2025-2026 season.

- Fond du Lac Thunder
- Fond du Lac Junior Warbirds
- St. Mary's Springs Hockey
- Fond du Lac Cardinals
- Fond du Lac Warbirds
- Fond du Lac Figure Skating Club
- Fond du Lac Blades

All skaters must have **current registration** with one of these organizations before stepping on the ice. Guests of members are allowed to participate on Rink C as long as the member is with the skaters.

## SUPERVISION & ACCESS

- **All minors (under 18)** must be supervised by a coach or guardian at all times while on or around the ice. **No unsupervised drop-offs** are allowed.
- Skaters who are **18 years old but graduated in the current school year (2024–2025)** still require adult supervision.
- Skaters may only use the ice during **scheduled Rink C times**, as listed on the Fond du Lac Blue Line website.

## SAFETY

- **Full protective gear** is required for all hockey activities, unless otherwise stated (e.g., Learn to Skate sessions).
- **No food or drinks** are allowed on the ice. Water bottles are permitted and must be kept safely off the ice surface.

---

## RESERVATION & USAGE RULES FOR MEMBERS

Fond du Lac Blue Line members may reserve Rink C ice time under the following conditions:

- Rink C will be locked during non-scheduled hours and not permitted to use.
- Members reserving Rink C must be registered for the 2025-2026 season or a current Board of Director.
- The reserving member must be **present** and is responsible for:
  - Supervising all on-ice activity
  - Opening and closing Rink C during the reserved time
  - Ensuring safety and compliance with policies
- **Reserved ice time is open to all members**, unless the reservation is:
  - Designated for a specific sport (hockey or figure skating) **and**
  - Limited by age level (e.g., Intro to Hockey through Bantam)
  - Reservations are limited to hours of operation only which is when Rink B is scheduled. The front doors to the rink will be locked outside of these hours. Members who are found to use Rink C outside of reservations and/or scheduled reservations will be fine charged \$300. Non-members will have the police called to issue trespassing citations.

- Members who wish to **restrict use to specific skaters** may **rent** the ice at:
  - \$100/hour for members
  - \$150/hour for non-members

Failure to supervise, follow the reservation rules, or close the rink properly may result in loss of future Rink C reservation privileges.

---

## SCHEDULING & RENTALS

- All Rink C reservations must be made **at least 24 hours in advance** through the Rink Manager.
  - The **online schedule** is the most accurate. The lobby TV schedule may not reflect real-time updates.
  - Coaches or organizations renting the rink must **pay in full** prior to use.
  - **Cancellations** must be made at least 24 hours in advance to avoid charges.
  - Any ice usage on Rink C without scheduled permission from Rink Manager could result in ice fees of ice rental per player on the ice.

## ICE MAINTENANCE

- During summer months, Rink C will be **zambonied each morning, Monday–Friday**.
  - **No additional zamboni service** will be provided for member-reserved sessions.
  - Zamboni service **will be provided** for all paid rentals (member or non-member).
