Varsity Overview

Heading into the **2008-09 season**, the concern of having only 4 returning Seniors (only 2 of them being letterman) was a thought in many people's eyes. The Tigers lost a large senior class, with 7 starting seniors, along with 4 state qualifiers gone. Was this going to be the year the Tigers get knocked off. *I think not.* The underclassmen put in numerous hours of off-season training, competition, and weight lifting from March – November, to make sure the *tradition* of Tiger Wrestling continues.

This season, as expected did have its peaks and valleys. With so many new wrestlers in the line-up, consistency was a problem throughout the season. This year's squad fought hard through adversity, injuries, setback, etc to reach their peak at the end of the season. The Tigers did see their 27 consecutive conference wins snapped on a Thursday in December, as we lost a battle to Granite City. The setback may have helped us, because everybody involved knew we were going to get them back. Less than one month later, the Tigers defeated O'Fallon marked by Mike Heinemeiers come from behind victory over Ercoline, to secure a tie for the *Conference Championship for the 4th year* in a row.

This year's team had the unique opportunity to wrestle the toughest schedule in the history of Edwardsville Wrestling. We started out with a bang, defeating Wentzville Holt twice to win the Fox Duals. The mid part of our season included 3 of the toughest tournaments around. I was extremely proud that our wrestlers welcomed the challenge, understanding to be the best we have to wrestle the best. Andrew Ellington led the pace of a 4th place finish at the Dvorak Tournament. Quincy Jackstadt got to the Finals again and places 2nd at the strongest Granite Tourney ever. The "Cheesehead" Tournament marked the return of Greg Jackson, as he placed 3rd in a very strong bracket. All of these tournaments and more prepared us for the final run of the season. Although many of our wrestlers entered Regionals with over 10 losses, the battle tested Tigers rose to the occasion with a decisive 32+ *point* victory over Granite City and O'Fallon. The depth of the Tigers played a role here and the rest of the season, as we placed top 4 in 13 of 14 weights. The team effort steam rolled into the post season as the Tigers fought their way to an impressive *4th Place in Dual Team State*, a mark that only the 2006 team has accomplished. It was just an unselfish, team first method that enabled us to accomplish this goal.

Individually the Tigers had just an outstanding Sectional at Lincoln Way Central. In what was the toughest sectional in years, Jackstadt, Jackson, Knoebel, and Ellington, all had career best Tournaments. Although the state tournament brought misfortune, the men can be proud of their season, and their training to get there. The way they bounced back on that Tuesday, keyed by Quincy Jackstadts clinching victory over Honenegah, is second to none.

The Seniors will be greatly missed, along with the 7 varsity letters of Captains Mike Heinemeier and Quincy Jackstadt. The effort and integrity of Tomas McClure, and Robbie Brueggemann saving his best day for last, greatly helping the Tigers place 4th in State. Remember all the ups and downs and special moments and friends you have met on your "*Journey*". Hopefully you will use all that you have learned and apply this to all of your future endeavors. "Remember the Journey", and that you will always be a Tiger Wrestler.

With the success this year's team found, and the amount of wrestlers returning, the 2010 season looks to be a good one. Unfortunately with success comes everybody else working harder to beat us. Only hard work and dedication will control next year's destiny. If we rest on our laurels, we will only find disappointment. Remember what got the Tigers to where we are today – *Off Season training*. The Off-Season starts *now*, and if you are not out for another sport, *spring and summer training should be attended*. Underclassmen, let's set our goals even higher than this year and advance to where no other team has gone – **A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP**.

Seniors, thanks again for all of the effort and memories. Coaches, thanks for being the best staff. Thanks go to all of the Edwardsville Coaches, from the middle schools to EWC. Booster Club, thanks for being the best and allowing us to wrestle the schedule that we do. Parents, thanks for supporting the vision of our program. Thanks to all involved in Edwardsville Wrestling, which is the culmination of many good people working toward one goal - success, fun, and a memorable Journey.

We finished the day with all of our wrestlers placing in the top four and five champions. Another great year of tournaments!!

We appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and helping mold them into not only champions on the mat but champions in life.


