Lynda Clark, President presented to the BBSC board of directors, the request for scholarship funds to be approved for Bob Greenwood SnowSports Scholarship. Approved for the 2025-26 season. Exact amount TBD, but looks to be in the range and up to \$4,000.

Champagne Brunch: The BGSS was introduced and Bob Greenwood was there to say a few words. Always a crowd favorite. Of the three 2024-25 scholarship award recipients, Noah Thomas - Snowboard came to speak. Carey read Nadege Lee's alpine season update and I read Bennett Oakey's alpine bio information.
