



Lettering/Patch Policy and Criteria

Cheyenne Youth Baseball Majors Teams

At this time, baseball is not recognized by the Wyoming High School Athletics Association. Even though that is the case, the Cheyenne Youth Baseball League baseball players will be given the opportunity to earn a letter by participation within our program. The following system will enable the players to be rewarded for their loyalty and hard work during their baseball career.

Player Guidelines

- All players are held accountable to all federal, state, local, county, and team laws, rules, and policies. Loss of eligibility is possible for any infractions.
- The player must be, at minimum, a freshman in high school at the start of the baseball season (first practice) and attend school during the season when applicable.
- All school related problems can result in loss of eligibility of lettering.
- Any player disrespecting coaches, umpires, teachers, administrators, parents, teammates, or community members are subject to loss of eligibility for lettering.
- All players will be on time to practices, games, meetings, and team functions.
- Player must always show respect for opposition. Cheyenne Youth Baseball League is not a program that will tolerate taunting, heckling or disrespect.

Lettering Criteria

PLAYERS MUST MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Regular attendance at all practice sessions/ "Snackshack" team coverage dates, proper use/return of all equipment and uniforms, and demonstration of the qualities of good sportsmanship and team loyalty.
- Player must adhere to all team rules and regulations, training rules, practice requirements and any other requests from the Cheyenne Youth Baseball League Manager and coaches throughout the season.
- Must have passed all registered classes, with a cumulative GPA of 2.0, by school year end. A copy of the player's report card must be provided for verification. It is the player's responsibility to provide a copy of grades either by electronic copy or hard copy as soon as possible.
- Sign the agreement acknowledging the lettering criteria.



AND AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING MUST BE MET:

- Seniors who have been in the Cheyenne Youth Baseball League for 4 consecutive seasons and complete all seasons in good standing (coaches' discretion).
- Any player that has been rostered on the **Majors** roster 75% of games played or more in a single season. (This will be tallied through June 30 in order to allow ordering time).
*Please note player must also meet the school level requirement (i.e. freshman, soph, jr, sr) as of April of current season.

THE FOLLOWING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHEYENNE YOUTH BASEBALL PROGRAM MANAGER/BOARD:

- Any player may receive a letter who has not reached the lettering criteria due to special circumstances under the Cheyenne Youth Baseball League Manager/Board discretion.

Loss of lettering eligibility

- Any player that violates the player guidelines or is removed from participation as a result in discipline, academic, legal, personal choice or parental measures may lose his privilege to letter if they do not stay in good standing with the team and/or coach.

The final decision on who shall receive a varsity letter will be at the discretion of the Cheyenne Youth Baseball League Program Manager/Board.



AGREEMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF LETTERING CRITERIA

I have read and understand the guidelines and criteria for the Cheyenne Youth Baseball League lettering program.
