Folkstyle State

Showcase Qualifier

- Indiana Girls' Wrestling champions also count for pre-qualifications.
- We maybe want to promote this event at state finals as well.

- Athletes who want to only wrestle in the HS qualifiers, can get a USA card for only \$5.

14U Duals

- These are being held at Franklin Community High School.
- Jimmy Tonte said Franklin needs COVID restriction sheet.

16U Duals

- These are being held at Grand Park
- Pat Culp finally heard back from them and they are working with her for arrangements.

Track Wrestling Scales

- Pat Culp reported the scales are here for the state finals.
- They did not come with scanners, has ordered them and will work with Justin early next week to get them set up.
- Scales can also score at tables.

Wrestlers cutting weight

- Pat Culp reported that one of the things we spoke about last meeting was weight loss. We had a couple of complaints about a club in section 1 about wrestlers cutting too much weight.
- The response we received from USA Wrestling is that they have a weight loss policy.
- She will write something up and get out to all clubs.
- It will basically say this is not something that we enforce, and Executive Committee will come up with some type of policy and procedure.

- It is hard to address unless we have some type of proof.
- We will dig in a bit further to see what stance ISWA will take on this.

- Jason DeLois gave information on concussions (Tennessee took this approach) with females forced to complete with male athletes and sooner or later a liability issue.

 9 references.

- 70% increase seen in the past when we had actual weight classes instead of combining.
- We can still do the Madison blocking if there are only 2 girls in a weight class, but they have the option to move up.
- They would still get their individual championship if they registered in a weight class that is combined.
- Showcase is coming up a little concerned with the numbers (only 50 entered at this time/ 41 boy and 9 girls).
- Girls Folkstyle Nationals 160 girls registered at this time (13 from Indiana).
- Will be taking a group of girls in a van showcase is on Saturday and Nationals on Sunday.
- Girls' wrestle offs were today. No one showed for wrestle offs.
- Now has a full team for Heartland Duals.
- Thinks we will do well.

- Would like to do a freestyle camp May 1st and 2nd. Was reminded that freestyle/Greco state is that weekend. Will discuss at coaches' council coming up with a new date.
- Would like to move forward with one order of gear for the whole year for the girls and would work with the new gear director.
