Since our founding in 2002, the mission of RiverFlow Soccer Club has been to use soccer as a vehicle for positive change in the City of Rochester, NY, and neighbouring communities. RiverFlow Soccer Club is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization with 100% volunteer coaches, managers and Board of Directors.

Our family of volunteers is dedicated to building productive responsible citizens and bridging racial, religious, cultural and socio-economic divides. Together we assist and guide our young people along the path from athlete to student to leader.

Recent data released by the U.S. Census Bureau showed that Rochester now ranks third in overall poverty among the 75 largest metropolitan areas in the United States. In 2023 51% of our participants received full scholarships, which is a full waiver of their registration fees. This places a tremendous financial burden on our club. RIVERFLOW'S STORY: LOCAL ACTION, GLOBAL REACH

ow in its 23rd year, River Flow Soccer Club (RFSC) is a not-for-profit, 501(c)(3) organization, with a 100% volunteer staff of coaches, managers and Board of Directors.

From its humble start in 2002, with only 32 players playing on two teams, RFSC has seen significant growth. In 2023 we had our greatest number of participants ever, with 35 children, aged 4-8, participating in our Academy, 165 girls and boys, aged 9-18, participating in our youth teams and 21 athletes on our adult team.

Soccer truely is the world's game, and our club's diversity is seen at every game and practice. Our athletes come to us from more than 12 different countries of birth!

We help our participants to become better students, athletes, and leaders. We explain that this is a continuous path of growth, not a final destination.

Mentoring our young people to become leaders is a priority at RFSC and part of our continuing efforts to break the cycle of poverty and violence among young people of color. Statistics show that a disproportionate number of Black and Hispanic young men are unemployed or involved in the criminal justice system. These young men are more than six times as likely to be victims of murder than their White peers and account

for almost half of the country's murder victims each year. (Source: My Brother's Keeper Alliance fact sheet.)

The success of these efforts is shown in the growing number of former RFSC youth players returning as adult leaders. Michael Henry (Head Coach and Board Member), Nekabari Tor (Head Coach), Omar Watts (Head Coach) and Liasor Dima (Board Member and Leadership Coordinator) are examples of former players who are now volunteering to mentor our young athletes, build personal relationships, and help them grow and thrive. It is with tremendous pride that we tell you that Nekabari and Liasor were members of the two original 2002 RFSC teams. 21 years later they are helping to improve RFSC and lead us for the next 20 years!

RiverFlow's family of volunteer is made up of more than 35 coaches, managers, and committee members, all dedicated to using soccer to improve the lives of those in our community.

RIVERFLOW: BY THE NUMBERS

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, Rochester ranks third in overall poverty among the 20 largest U.S. cities with the highest poverty rates.

In 2002, the year of our founding, RiverFlow had only 32 players playing on two teams.

In 2023, 51% of our participants received full scholarships, which is a full waiver of their registration fee.

In 2023 we had our largest number of participants ever: 135 athletes on our eight travel soccer teams, 23 athletes in our girls' program, 25 children participating in our Academy program, 26 participants in our Heidi's Wish Summer Camp and 20 athletes on our adult team.

THE PROBLEM: LACK OF FUNDING

The fact that all of our staff and coaches are volunteers allows us to keep the costs as low as possible. For our travel soccer teams, student-athletes aged 8-19, the yearly registration fee is only \$450. For our Academy, ages 4-7, the yearly registration fee is only \$75.

Despite this low fee, many of our families are unable to afford the cost. RiverFlow has never turned anyone away due to an inability to pay, and we provide financial aid for families dealing with financial hardships. In 2023, 51% of our participants received a 100% waiver of their registration fees. While this is a great aid to our families, it places a tremendous financial burden on our Club. We must pay annually for insurance, uniforms, equipment, league fees and more. Finding funds to cover these expenses is a serious problem.

EXPENSES FOR A RIVERFLOW STUDENT-ATHLETE'S SEASON



Equipment

Shinguards, waterbottles, cleats and goalie gloves can cost between \$75- \$100 per player each season.



League Fees

League fees include background checks for all our volunteers, insurance and League administration costs.



Referee Fees

League games are officiated by professional referees, who are paid for every game they officiate.



Each player receives their uniforms at no additional cost. They each receive a training shirt, a home jersey, an away jersey, one pair of game socks and one pair of game shorts.

Tournament Fees

RiverFlow Soccer programs are committed to teaching the fundamentals of teamwork, not just technical skills. When our student-athletes succeed as a team, they grow together. Tournaments provide a unique opportunity for additional competition and exposure to college scouts.
