SOLE POWER

Is a free green commuting challenge for the Eagle Valley community. The challenge runs from Memorial Day through Indigenous People's Day.

Participants track their mileage and carbon emissions saved throughout the season. It's a fun and healthy way to commute, stay active, save money—and most importantly—reduce your carbon footprint!

SHIFT BIKE E-BIKE SHARE PROGRAM

Single-occupancy vehicles, such as small cars and trucks, account for 42 percent of Eagle County's greenhouse gas emissions.

The e-bike share system is designed to help residents and employees shift their ride – away from car trips and on to e-bikes for short trips and daily commutes.

This regional e-bike share program is transforming our community by building a high-quality, sustainable, and affordable system that:

- Reduces first-and-last mile challenges/ Supplements public transit /Reduces greenhouse gas emissions and air pollution
- Encourages active and healthy forms of transportation/ Increases access to e-bikes

MAJOR PROJECTS & INVESTMENTS

GERALD R. FORD AMPHITHEATER IN VAIL:

\$20 million renovation over 3 winters (2025–2028). Enhanced seating, safety railings, extended operating season, food/beverage expansion, and modernized facilities.

Expected to boost Vail's economy by \$3M annually.

VILAR PERFORMING ARTS CENTER IN BEAVER CREEK:

Recent \$2 million upgrade post-25th anniversary. New sound system, lighting, HVAC, projection, bar, and coat check.

VAIL DANCE FESTIVAL ENDOWMENTS:

Carol F. Storr Endowment for Classical Ballet ensures long-term support for classical dance. Artistic Direction Endowment supports sustainable, high-quality leadership.

• WORLD-CLASS SKI RACING

EXPANSION OF BIRDS OF PREY WORLD CUP RACES:

- Men's and Women's events secured, boosting regional economic impact (\$6.8M in 2024).
- \$10 million gift from John and Karen Arnold led to naming of Red Tail Stadium and long-term race support.

DOBSON ARENA REMODEL PROJECT:

The Town of Vail began its highly anticipated remodel of Dobson Arena in April 2025. Construction is expected to take approximately 18 months to complete, with an anticipated reopening at the end of September 2026.

Key improvements include:

- New West and South entrances
- New mechanical screened yards (NE and NW)
- Hockey capacity for 1,400+ staff viewing
- Maximum standing capacity of 2,400 on the floor
- Event capacity of over 3,500 + 100 staff
- 43 additional bathroom fixtures
- Up to 40 internal bathrooms for 2,080 guest capacity
- Potential for 30 more bathrooms pending approval of North restrooms
- Rigging design input provided by AEG to support event production, such as concerts.
- Current users are fundraising to secure additional ice time in Eagle for this winter. Go to givebutter.com/RodeoRink
