Financial Review

Review of Profit and Loss (P&L)

- Profits
 - Total Income \$106K with approximately \$10K-\$15K additional later this year
 - Raffle was ~\$40K
 - Sponsors didn't come in as well this year
 - DIBS buy-outs were lower
 - We will need a DIBS manager
- Expenses
 - Well was \$12K
 - Bench, patio, drag, and tarps ~\$20K
- Overall, when everything settles ~\$90K
 - If we want to spend money, we could be comfortable spending ~\$60K
- Brian Zell question if we do any other money raising events or fundraisers
 - Not besides the concessions, raffle, and season fees
 - We would be open to changes and doing things off season
- Brian Zell How do you hold people accountable for DIBS?
 - \$20 per hour fee and cannot play until it's paid out
 - Sometimes offer a task to do based on skillset

Raffle & Re-Raffle

2022 Raffle Summary

• 31 total prizes, 12 chose cash (38.7%), 19 chose prize (61.3%)

2023 Raffle Summary (So Far)

- 34 total prizes, 22 chose cash (65%), 10 chose prize (29%), 2 yet to respond
- What do we do with the other prizes? Re-raffle doesn't seem feasible
 - We will silent auction the remaining prizes
 - Andy Adams will lead this

MYB Potential Projects

Concession Stand

- \$150-200K to rebuild the entire building
 - o Cannot do this with a loan as we cannot use the property as collateral
 - o How would we do a grant or sponsor?
 - Hard to get. We didn't even get enough sponsors to have one per team this year
- Property is loaned to us from the school every 10-year renewal
- \$50-60K to do a partial upgrade

New F1 Batting Cage

- ~\$36K
- Not the same size as the original cage
- Saves from going to other field's cages

F3 Batting Cage Updates

~\$3K to upgrade/fix

Grass Infield

- \$40K upfront cost
 - o \$40K includes portable mounds, grass on all three fields, and sprinkler updates
 - Based on quote by JT Landscaping LLC
- Infield quote comparisons
 - \$30K to do the infield work by JT Landscaping LLC
 - September Timeline
 - \$65K for same work by Stern
 - They would want sponsorship and large sign for 10 years
 - Stern was looking at doing the batting cages as well
 - Stern timeline was sooner
- Sprinkler systems already installed, and would just need to extend
- Many benefits listed in project proposal document
- Maintenance on current fields tough due to a lot of use
 - o Open to the public, lots of practice, games, etc. (even past city league)

Wiffle Ball Field

- \$25-120K based on desired field quality
- Grass, fence, dirt baselines
- Andy Kolodziej How would it be used?
 - o Open ended
 - o Potentially Rookie league uses it
 - o If Rookie league uses this, we could potentially figure out better times for the other leagues
- Could we split costs by doing the field this year and do the fence next year?

Review of Above Projects by Board

- Concession Stand
 - We will have to do this using sponsors
 - Will not be worth us putting MYB money into this
- New F1 Batting Cage
 - o Could we do a single cage for less?
- F3 Batting Cage Upgrade
- Grass Infield
 - 50ft mounds and 70ft base paths (other combinations mentioned as well per field size)
 - Will need this to keep players competitive
 - Other cities are doing this
 - Opens us up to many future opportunities it's for the players
 - Moveable mounds can be used for softball and baseball
 - A lot cheaper to replace than alternative
 - Which company do we go with? Is the extra \$35K worth it for Stern?
 - Discussion on this and concluded to go with JT Landscaping LLC
- Wiffle Ball Field
 - o This is a want, not a need probably not worth the return at this time compared to other options
- Bleachers and picnic tables
- Backstop pads
 - \$500 per field will address this at spring meetings
