PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT

BYBF has implemented the following Code of Conduct as a method of promoting the important message concerning positive support of our children in sports. Please read and sign below prior to enrolling your child/children in BYBF.

1. I will remember that children participate in sports to have fun and that the game is for youth and not adults
2. I will remember that coaches for this program are volunteers – not paid professionals. I will accept that not all coaches possess the same level of baseball/softball knowledge.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will be a positive role model; encouraging good sportsmanship by showing respect and positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game/practice.
5. I will never ridicule any child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
6. I understand that athletes are required to attend practices to be eligible to participate in games.
7. I will promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of the athletes ahead of my own desire to win.
8. I understand that because practices and games are held on school property; if my child is suspended from school they will not be allowed to practice or play during the suspension. Once the suspension is lifted the player will be allowed to practice but will be required to sit out the first game following the suspension period.
9. I agree to not bring or allow dogs on any of the fields per Blaine School District Policy.
10. I am aware that use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana and any other drug is prohibited with the gated area of the Pipeline Complex per BSD Policy.
11. I will remember that there are children present at any given time in the Pipeline Complex parking lot. I agree to drive in a slow manner; keeping the safety and wellbeing of all participants in mind.

By signing the Code of Conduct I agree to comply with the Code and acknowledge that any failure to comply with any provisions of the Code could lead to disciplinary action. Any course of action will be at the discretion of the BYBF Board.

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

As a good teammate I agree to:

- Be respectful and courteous to all coaches, players, umpires and opponents
- Be a good teammate – be positive and supportive – show good sportsmanship
- Give 100% effort in practice and games
- Listen carefully and follow the directions of my coaches
- Make every attempt to be on time and ready to play for all games and practices
- Contact my coach at least 2 hours before game time if I am going to be absent from the game
- Take care of the league equipment and only use another player's personal equipment if given permission
- Stay in the dugout during games – unless I have permission from my coach to leave
- Make sure no garbage is left behind in the dugouts after games and practices
- Talk to my coach if I have a problem so that they can help me resolve it

By signing I agree to follow the Code of Conduct and I understand that if I break any of the rules there will be consequences.
