MEMBERSHIP FYI'S



A portion is also utilized for Region management/administration (staff, office, supplies, meetings).

The remaining \$22.50 goes to the USA Volleyball National office to help pay for sport accident and liability insurance, support coaching and officials' training, education, and development of support materials provided to the Regions. Additionally the National office utilizes funds for sport development and promotion, maintain a national database, membership services and the National management (staff, office, etc..) which we rely on as the backbone of the Region..
