

#### Wildcats Storylines ...

**BATTLE OF THE WILDCATS:** Saint Ignatius will take on the Springfield Wildcats for the first time in program history. Springfield comes out of Region 2 in Division 1 and lost in the State Semifinal in 2020 to St. Xavier. Both schools share the same mascot of a Wildcat and both have primary colors of blue and gold. This will be a playoff-like match-up right from the jump.

**QB 1:** Joey Pfaff enters 2021 as a returning starter from the 2020 season. After rotating at quarterback early in 2020, Pfaff has emerged as the signal-caller for Coach Chuck Kyle's offense. Pfaff can get it done with his arm and his legs and has improved mightily reading defenses. The Canton McKinley scrimmage highlighted Pfaff's ability to escape the pocket under pressure on a 3 & 14 and convert for a first down on the rush. After a shortened season under center last season, the senior looks to flourish with a ten-game regular season schedule.

**MACK PACK:** The stable returns Marty Lenehan from last season. Lenehan was terrific on the ground for the offense totaling 636 yards on 113 carries, punching the rock in for a touchdown seven times in his junior season. Lenehan has gotten even stronger over the off-season, and it takes more than one defender to get him down to the turf. Other rotational backs will include senior Joey Georges and sophomore Sean Martin. Luke Baker '17 enters his first season as the running backs coach as the alumnus is excited to see what his group can do in 2021.

**MEN UP FRONT:** The Wildcats bring back two returning starters on the offensive line. Senior Ashton Montgomery and senior Brian Keane will anchor the Wildcats as left and right tackles this year. Looking at the guards, senior Joe Ryland and junior Dominic Ference will lock down the left and right guard spots. Junior Pat Lavelle will be the center for the Wildcats offense for 2021. William Witalis will be a key reserve for the Wildcats and can play any position on the line.

**TRENCH WAR:** The Saint Ignatius defensive line plays with high intensity for 48 minutes. Leading the way on the line is Peter Chalhoub, who can play a little bit of end and nose for the Wildcats 3-4 defense. In 2020, Chalhoub earned 13.5 tackles, five of them being for a loss, 2.5 sacks and a forced safety as a rotational lineman. Thomas Wasinski will be a crucial piece for the Wildcats line as the 5'10" 255 lbs nose tackle cut 20 lbs in the off-season into lean muscle. Eugene Gibbons, Ryan Boomer and Will Robinson will see a significant amount of time on the defensive line.

**AERNI'S QUARTET:** The Wildcats have a significant amount of talent coming out of the linebacker position. At middle backer will be Christopher Aerni. Aerni last season was a rotational backer that earned a starting role late in the season. Aerni accumulated 10.5 tackles, with 3.5 of them being for a loss. Aerni has great recognition of offensive schemes and will be a leader for the linebacker core. Surrounding him will be senior Gavin Berger, senior Blase Mastrianni and junior Max Palinski. The linebacking core looks to have a big season for the Wildcat defense.

**NO FLY ZONE:** A strength for the Wildcat defense this season will be the secondary. At the free safety position, senior Griffin Taliak will be the satellite for the Saint Ignatius defense. Taliak last season earned a starting role as a junior, totaling 30.5 tackles, 2 for a loss and two pass break-ups. Braeden Lair will be the strong safety for the Wildcats. Both Lair and Taliak are members of the Saint Ignatius Lacrosse program and look to be nightmares for an opponent's passing game. The main staple for corners will be Joe Norris, Jack Mangan and Franklin Pike, with rotational help from Edwin Abiakl.

**SPECIALIST:** Zeb Eldridge is the definition of a world-class kicker. He is ranked in the top 50 of high school punters and kickers for his talent in the special teams game. Eldridge averages about 45-50 yards a punt and Coach Kyle will use that to his advantage when playing the field position game in 2021.

**OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN:** The captains for the 2021 season are #22 Marty Lenehan, #34 Christopher Aerni, #95 Peter Chalhoub and #99 Thomas Wasinski.

### ABOUT SPRINGFIELD ...

#### Learning about the Wildcats ...

**THE SMOOT FILE:** Te'Sean Smoot comes into 2021 after a remarkable junior season, leading the Wildcats to the OHSAA Division I semifinal. Smoot threw for 2,269 yards a season ago, completing nearly 60% of his passes. Smoot threw an impressive 24 touchdowns in the 2020 season, including a career-high of five touchdown throws against Beavercreek in a 76-0 rout. Smoot is a dual-threat and can hurt you with his speed, as last season, he totaled 603 yards on 122 attempts, scoring nine touchdowns. He rushed over the century mark in two post-season games against Huber Heights Wayne and St. Xavier.

AIR RAID: Smoot's favorite target appears to be junior Anthony Brown. Brown, as a sophomore, gained 1,000+ all-purpose yards for the Wildcats. Brown averaged just about 113 yards per game and led the Greater Western Ohio Conference in receiving in 2020. Brown is also a threat for the big play on special teams, returning kick-offs and punts for Springfield. Springfield's number two option will be Shawn Thigpen, who is listed at 6'4" 170 lbs coming into this season. Last season Thigpen racked up 265 yards on 19 receptions and three touchdowns and has been given offers to play at the next level from Kentucky and Toledo.

**CHAMPIONSHIP CHASING:** The Wildcats were close to competing for a State Championship last season, losing a tight battle in the semifinal to the eventual champions St. Xavier Bombers. Springfield has played in the State Semifinal game in the previous two seasons. Coming into this season, Springfield has its eyes set on another deep run in the OHSAA playoffs. The Wildcats offensive line has massive depth, give Smoot exponential time in the pocket and giving receivers times to find holes in a defense. Springfield can hurt a team with just one play with their explosive offense.

**DEFENSIVE FIREPOWER:** Last season St. Xavier was a juggernaut on offense, winning the State Championship 44-3. Despite the loss in the semifinal round, the Wildcats held the Bombers to just 12 points, proving Springfield's powerhouse on defense. Seniors Vasean Washington, Tayden Harper and ZyAaron Woodruff are the main staples of the Wildcats defense that return in 2021. Joe Abston and Sean Ivey will bolster the defensive unit returning to play after sitting out last season due to the pandemic. Linebacker Jaivian Norman also returns for the Wildcats as he led the team in tackles a season ago with 77 as a sophomore. Senior Delian Bradley became a star last season in his free safety position as he totaled 66 tackles and six interceptions. Bradley has received more than 20 Division I scholarship offers heading into 2021.



#### **QB JOEY PFAFF '22**



Joey Pfaff rotated in the quarterback position in his junior season before winning the starter role late in the 2020 season. Joey led the Wildcats to two playoff victories last season against Solon and Euclid.

Pfaff a season ago completed 58% of his passes, throwing for 894 yards and six touchdowns in the shortened season. With a full schedule ahead of him, Pfaff looks to have a big season for the Blue and Gold.

The Pfaff name may sound familiar to the Wildcat faithful as his dad, Eric '81, was a hard hitting linebacker for the Wildcats in the early 80s. Eric is in the Saint Ignatius Athletic Hall of Fame.

#### **DL PETER CHALHOUB '22**



Peter Chalhoub will be the leader and catalyst of the defensive line in 2021. Chalhoub, a captain, is looking for a breakout year in his final season wearing the blue and gold. Chalhoub took a lot of experience away from playing alongside Bennett Adler '21 a season ago.

Chalhoub received his first opportunity late in the 2020 season and he shined, accumulating 13.5 tackles, with five of them being for a loss, 2.5 sacks and a forced safety. This will be Chalhoub's third season on varsity and the 6'2 250 lbs defensive end will look to be a nightmare for an opponent's offensive line.

Evans Stadium was named after St Dr. Charles Wesley Evans who practiced in Springfield for 64 years. He served on the school board for 16 years and is reported to have delivered 4500 babies. For the 2021 Season, the Wildcats will play host at their high school in a stadium that has a stadium capacity of 5,241.

The Springfield faithful enjoyed a memorable 2020 season, watching their Wildcats make it to the OHSAA State Semifinal in Division I. Springfield would fall 12-10 against the eventual Division I champion St. Xavier Bombers. Now, the Wildcats have their eye on a State Championship.

### **GAME PREVIEW**

#### A BATTLE OF THE WILDCATS

After a shortened regular season in 2020 due to the pandemic, the 2021 Saint Ignatius Wildcats are ready for an entire ten-game season.

2020 without question, was a challenging year for all. Program-wise, the season began on a delay as the Wildcats did not take the field for their first game until September 12 and only played four regular-season games. The Wildcats did have success in the postseason, making a nice run until ultimately falling to the Medina Bees in the Regional Semifinal by the score of 33-26.

The Wildcats come into 2021 reloaded and ready to make some noise in the region after a regular off-season with camps and double sessions; the Cats are hungry to begin as it will be a battle of the Wildcats to kick off the season.

#### SAINT IGNATIUS OFFENSE VS. SPRINGFIELD DEFENSE

Springfield comes into the 2021 regular season ranked number four in the state after another semifinal appearance in the OHSAA Division I Playoffs. Head Football Coach Chuck Kyle' 69 understands that the Wildcat offense will be the key for success against Springfield when the season kicks off on August 20.

"The offense has to help the defense," explains Kyle. "We have to have good drives and get points on the board and not worry about the scoreboard."

Although cut short due to mother nature, the Wildcats offense established the ground game out of the gates. Marty Lenehan will be a focal point in the early stages vs. Springfield.

Springfield is disciplined on defense as they limit the big play by an opponent's offense. Springfield will be in man coverage most of the game but will occasionally switch into a zone during a game. "They live and die being in man coverage," says Kyle. "Their defensive line is excellent, which I think will be a great challenge for our offensive line."

Springfield brings back their hard-hitting defense consisting of seniors Vasean Washington, Tayden Harper, and ZyAaron Woodruff, which will be the main staples of the defense. Joe Abston and Sean Ivey will add depth on the defensive unit returning to play after sitting out last season due to the pandemic. Line-backer Jaivian Norman also returns for Springfield as he led the team in tackles a season ago with 77 as a sophomore. Senior Delian Bradley has received more than 20 Division I scholarship offers heading into his senior season.

"We have to do our part offensively," explains Kyle. "This is a team that can hurt you with just one play."

#### SAINT IGNATIUS DEFENSE VS. SPRINGFIELD OFFENSE

The defense for the Wildcats returns eight starters from the 2020 season.

The secondary appears to be the most vital facet of the Wildcat defense, returning players such as Braeden Lair, Griffin Taliak, Joe Norris and Jack Mangan. Norris can play in the safety slot and cornerback position, so the secondary is flexible to rotate defensive backs and safeties. The Wildcats secondary must be ready to shut down the air attack of three-year starting quarterback Te'Sean Smoot.

Junior Anthony Brown is Springfield's number one target coming into 2021. Brown went over 1,000+ all-purpose yards last season on his way to lead all of the Greater Western Ohio Conference. The number two option for Springfield is just as dangerous in Shawn Thigpen. Thigpen had a productive summer on the field, receiving offers from the Division I level from Toledo and Kentucky. Thigpen and Brown give any defenses trouble and open the field up for their QB, Smoot

Smoot is a dual-threat quarterback that can read any coverage well while making intelligent decisions with the football. In his junior year, Smoot threw 24 touchdowns, guiding Springfield to another semifinal game. This season Smoot has one goal in mind, win a State Championship. The Wildcat defense must be ready to limit Smoot.

"They have an explosive offense," says Kyle. "If they are sitting on the sidelines, they are not so explosive, so we have to get their offense off the field early."

The Wildcats will need to make Springfield work hard for their points and limit the big plays on the road.

"They'll make some plays," Kyle says. "Let's not give them that one play touchdown drive; make them earn it"

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS**

Coach Kyle has made it a common practice that the importance of the special teams game can give you a significant advantage. Zeb Eldridge will be the man on call for kicks and punts for the Wildcats. Eldridge is ranked in the top 50 for punts and kicks and will be an excellent piece for coach Kyle's unit.

"Their kicking game is good, but I'm hoping ours is better," says Kyle. "I think we can have long kick-offs, punts and field goals which will be a plus in our category."

This is a heavyweight fight and it's the Battle of the Wildcats; the 2021 high school football season has finally arrived.


