

PARENT / SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

By entering or attending this event, or any other CEVA-sanctioned event, you agree to abide by this code of conduct.

I WILL

1. I WILL abide by the official rules of USA Volleyball.

Examples: Reading the USAV Rule Book & USAV Code of Conduct.

2. I WILL display good sportsmanship at all times.

Examples: Positive reinforcement of a good play by either team. Thanking officials.

- 3. I WILL educate myself on the unique rules of this facility and abide by them.
 - Example: Where are the camp areas? Where is food allowed?
- 4. I WILL generate goodwill by being polite & respectful to those around me. Example: Saying "good game" to spectators around you after a match.
- 5. I WILL contribute to a welcoming and positive environment and will recognize the student-athletes on the court are the main focus.
- 6. I WILL immediately notify the Event Director and/or Program Administrator in the event that I witness any illegal activity.
- 7. I WILL acknowledge that the spectator seating around the courts is for the primary use of those watching the match in progress.
- 8. I WILL acknowledge that spectators may rightfully choose to remain in a seat for an entire match without switching sides of the court when the teams switch.

I WILL NOT

1. I WILL NOT harass or intimidate the officials including line judges and scorekeepers.

Example: Please do not say anything to a score table crew member or referee. Remember: The flip scoreboard is the <u>unofficial</u> score of a match.

- 2. I WILL NOT participate in any game or game-like activities unless I have a current membership card with USA Volleyball.
- 3. I WILL NOT bring and/or carry any firearms at any USA Volleyball event.
- 4. I WILL NOT bring, purchase, or consume alcohol at any Youth/Junior volleyball event. Example: Spectator tailgating with alcohol is prohibited.
- 5. I WILL NOT engage in racist, discriminatory, derogatory, or exclusionary actions of any kind.
- 6. I WILL NOT display symbols, language, signage, or placards of any kind that are traditionally deemed offensive, racist, or derogatory.

Examples: Confederate flag, Confederate Battle Emblem, Tomahawk Chop.

NOTICE

Risk of injury from flying objects incidental to the sport of Volleyball may occur at this event. Attend at your own risk. Please pay close attention to your surroundings and be alert at all times, especially during active play.

This tournament is sanctioned by USA Volleyball, and as such, is a private event. Admission to this event is a revocable privilege. Actions that violate this Code of Conduct, actions that are racist, sexist, derogatory, discriminatory in nature, or actions otherwise deemed in violation of CEVA or USAV standards, will be cause for removal from the premises.
