

Good morning CRCBC families,

As many of you heard last evening, Governor Walz has issued a pause on all youth sports for the state of Minnesota starting Saturday, November 21st. This is tentatively set for 4 weeks. CRCBC will follow the guidelines set forth by the State of Minnesota as we look for a return to play date. As a board, our main focus this year has been the health and safety of our athletes and families. Any decisions made in the future will continue to have the same focus. While we know that this is disappointing to our players and families, we also understand that the health of our surrounding community is important.

CRCBC will cease all practice and game activity by Friday at 11:59 PM. If your team is scheduled for practice tomorrow or Friday, you are welcome to practice. However, if you are not comfortable having your athlete attend practice, please keep them home.

Our home tournament for the boys, and the Centennial Tournament for the girls, scheduled for this weekend, have been postponed.

Next Steps:

1. **Future Tournaments.** We will be in touch with the associations that were scheduled to host tournaments in the next four weeks. Once we know their plans, (refunding or rescheduling) we will have a better understanding of what the rest of our season may look like in regards to how many tournaments we will be able to play, and if there will be any refunds offered at the end of the season.
2. **Refunds.** CRCBC has a policy regarding refunds for a canceled season, however, since this is only a pause please give the board some time to figure out the financial cost of this pause.
3. **Keep Working!** During this four-week time frame, we would like to remind our players to continue to work on their education as well as their basketball game. Players can dribble in their basement, watch YouTube basketball workout videos, or watch basketball games on TV. Another great resource for virtual training is Midwest Basketball Training.
