We will be using 3 playing sites for this year's Presidents' Day Tournament.

All matches best of 3, first two sets to 25. If needed, deciding 3<sup>rd</sup> set to 15. All sets win by 2, no cap.

Warm-ups: 2-4-4 for initial matches. Warm-ups may be shortened to 3-3 if courts are running behind schedule or mutually consented. Shagging balls for each other is encouraged.

Work teams will need to be on time and provide an R2, 2 line judges, a scorekeeper, a libero tracker, and a scoreboard operator. **Coaches must stay in the area** of their team for the entirety of their reffing assignment. Failure to fully comply with the above may result in USA Volleyball sanctions in their following match.

Due to us having more courts available on Sunday than Saturday the 11/12 Classic division has only 2 matches on Saturday. That is not an error, your teams will have just 2 matches on Saturday but all teams in the 11/12 Classic division will get at 3 or 4 matches on Sunday.

USA-Volleyball Rules will be followed including the following tie-breaking criteria:

No tie-breaking sets will be played for tied teams at the conclusion of pool play.

2 teams tied – tie-breaker = head to head

3 or more teams tied – tie-breaker order = match record, sets record, point percentage, coin-flip.

All live results will be posted on AES.

- Pricing for spectator admission is \$25 for a weekend pass, or \$15 for a day pass

- Tickets will be sent in a PDF to the email you use to purchase.
- Players, Rostered Coaches, and Children 10 and under do not need a ticket for entry. The wristbands must be worn on your wrist the entire weekend. Wristbands attached to a purse/bag or pulled out of your pocket to show us will not be accepted.
- **Tickets are valid at all three playing venues.**
- \*No ticket refunds will be provided.

**Team Check-In: Official team rosters are through online check in on AES. Club Directors please have your teams checked in on AES by Noon on Thursday. Coaches check-in will be Saturday prior to your first match.** Coaches check-in will comprise of confirming your roster (Age waivers see below) and receiving your coaches' wristbands. Check-in at the RecPlex will be done in the Blue Room of the Rec Plex, check-in at U.W. Parkside will happen at the tournament desk, and check-in at JAC will happen at the tournament desk as well. Check-in times are 7:15 a.m.-8:30 a.m and again from 1:00-3:00 p.m.

**Age waivers are accepted.** Please present region or governing body written proof of granted waiver at time of Coaches check-in at your playing site on Saturday. Age Waiver players will not show up on AES, so this player will need to be added by the site directors when coaches check-in with written proof of the waiver.

**11/12 Classic Division Step-In Rule:** We will be using the Badger Region Step-In Rule for the 11's/12 Classic division. I have attached the rule and it will be posted at the event as well. Coaches this is a "spirit of the game" rule to help young players who can't serve yet from the endline. Please do not abuse this rule by having strong servers use this adaptation for a competitive advantage

**Athletic Trainers:** There will be an athletic trainer at the Rec Plex and UW Parkside playing sites for the entirety of the tournament. Rolls of athletic tape will be available for purchase from each site's trainer.

**Team Awards:** T-Shirts will be awarded for champions, and Medals will be awarded to the top 3 teams. **(Gold Bracket Only).**

**Individual Recognition:** All tournament team recognition for all divisions. 3 players from the 1<sup>st</sup> place team, and 2 players from the 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> place teams.. **(Gold Bracket Only).**

#### **REC PLEX:**

The front lot at the Rec Plex is a membership only lot that requires a membership pass or partnership parking pass. There is a 250 stall parking lot across the street, as well as baseball field parking lots just at the end of the main parking area. The Park N Ride lot, street parking

and the parking lot at the ball fields will be open and **free** to all volleyball guests. Coolers are not allowed in the Rec Plex.

### **UW-Parkside:**

Bleacher seating is limited on a few courts at UW Parkside, so **bringing a portable bag chair is encouraged**. There are free parking lots on both the Northwest and South sides of the facility.

Courts 4-7 will be located inside the Frank Petretti Fieldhouse.

Courts 1-3 will be located inside the DeSimone Arena.

No carry-ins allowed at UW-Parkside

Bleacher seating should be sufficient, **portable bag chairs are allowed**.

### **Division Formats:**

**13 Classic, 14 Premier, and 15/16 Club:** 16 teams - Four 4 team pools

- On Saturday, the 4 team pools will play 3 matches of pool play.
- The 1st and 2nd place teams will advance to Gold Challenge matches
- Winners/Losers of the Gold Challenge Matches will advance to a Gold/Silver bracket respectively and the 3rd and 4th place teams from pool play will advance to the Bronze and Copper brackets.

**13 Premier, 16-Classic:** 12 Teams - Three 4 team pools

- On Saturday, each team will play 3 matches of pool play.
- Based on record in pool play, teams will move to 1 of 2 brackets on Sunday.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams to 6- Team Gold Bracket played out to place finishes.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place teams to a 6-Team Silver Bracket played out to place finishes.

**12 Premier:** 8 Teams - Two 4 team pools

- On Saturday, each team will play 3 matches of pool play.
- All teams will advance to Gold Challenge matches

- Winners/Losers of the Gold Challenge Matches will advance to a Gold/Silver bracket respectively.

**14 Classic:** 24 teams - Six 4 team pools

- On Saturday, each team will play 2 matches of pool play and finish last match of pool play on Sunday.
- Based on record in pool play, teams will move to 1 of 4 brackets on Sunday.
  - 1st place teams to Gold
  - 2nd place teams to Silver
  - 3rd place teams to Bronze
  - 4th place teams to Copper

**15 Classic:** 19 teams - Five 3 team pools and One 4 team pool

- On Saturday, each team will play their pool play matches
- Additionally, teams in 3 team pools will play a 3-team double challenge bracket
- Based on double challenge bracket finishes and pool play finish for the 4-team pool, teams will move brackets on Sunday.
  - 1st place teams to Gold
  - 2nd place teams to Silver
  - 3rd and 4<sup>th</sup> place teams will be placed in a 4-Team Bronze Bracket or a 3-Team Bronze Pool.

**11/12 Classic:** 24 Teams – Eight pools of 3 Teams

- On Saturday, each team will play 2 matches of pool play.
- All teams play a will play a 3-team Double Challenge Bracket to start play on Sunday.
- Based on Double Challenge Bracket finishes teams will move to Gold Challenge Matches or Copper and Bronze Brackets.
  - 1st place teams to Gold Challenge with winners/losers of Gold Challenges advancing to Gold/Silver Brackets accordingly.
  - 2nd place teams to Bronze Brackets.
  - 3rd place teams to Copper Brackets.

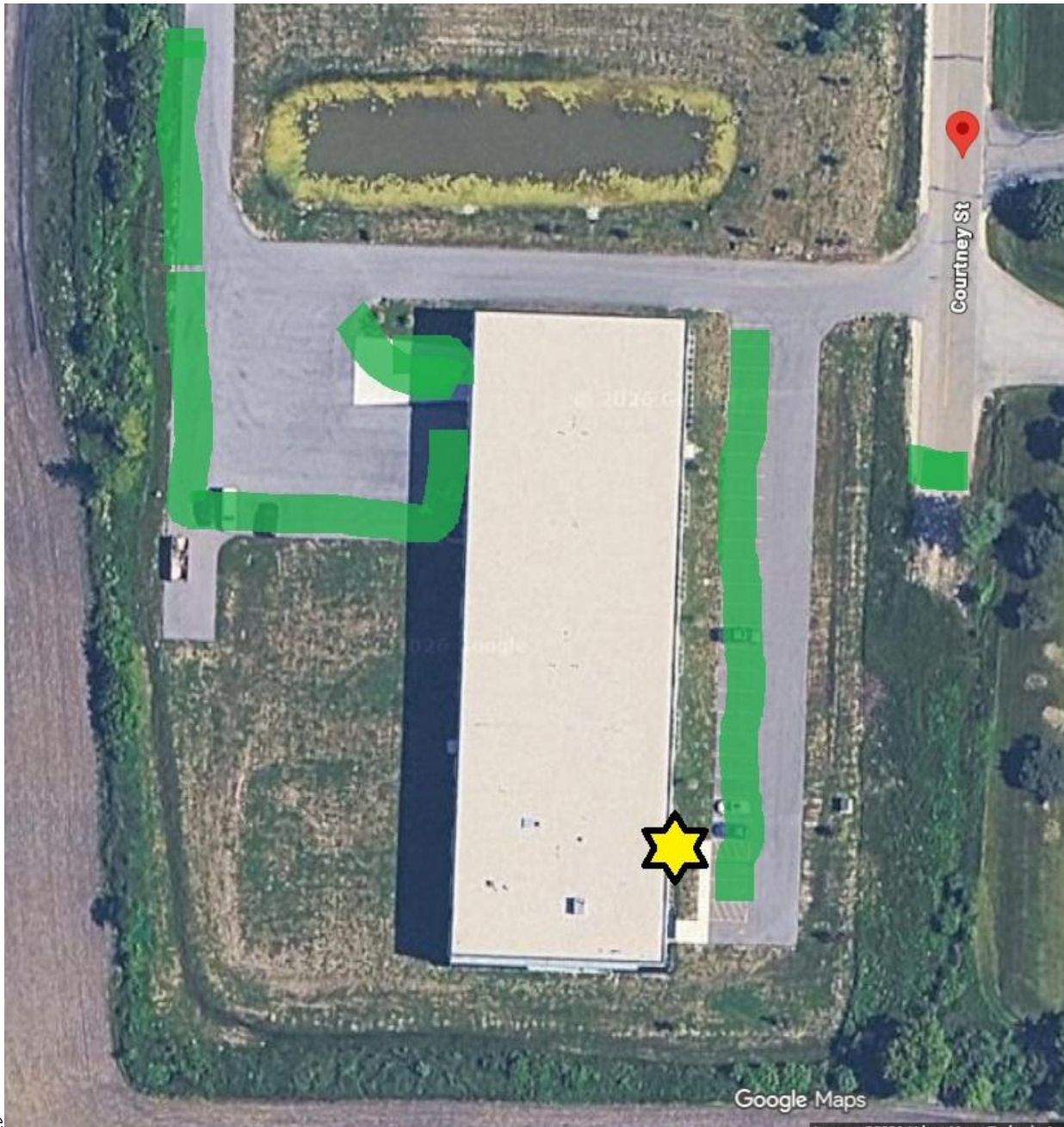
