

Club Scholarships

With money raised from SRJ Home tournaments, SRJ is happy to provide a small amount of scholarships towards an athlete's club dues each year. The amount available for scholarships can vary year-to-year.

Awarded scholarships may consist of a set amount off club dues, $\frac{1}{4}$ of dues, $\frac{1}{2}$ of club dues, and full coverage scholarships. Each application is given consideration for the above dependent on the number of applicants, and club costs for each year.

If you wish to request a scholarship for your athlete, please download, complete, and return the scholarship application form found on our website.

Scholarships do not cover the cost of uniform, or travel/food/lodging.

Scholarship awardees will be required to participate in volunteer activities with the board including any fundraising events that are scheduled and/or help run home tournament activities including T-Shirt booth, concessions, set up & tear down.

GEAR & UNIFORMS

Team apparel (jerseys, spandex, knee pads, etc.) are not included in your club membership costs.

The team store to order your jersey will open after your team's commitment night. We will have sample sizes available for your athlete to try on before ordering.



- ★ Numbers for jerseys are on a first come first-served basis.
- ★ New jerseys must be purchased each year as the colors and styles available through the distributor change and team uniforms must match exactly (excluding libero)

Team store for warm-ups and other optional fan apparel will open the same day as uniforms but will close within two weeks after commitment night.
