

SETH BRIZEK

Seth was an outstanding all-around athlete from Oley High School graduating in 1992. In baseball he was a member of the 1989 state championship team and is the Oley career leader in home runs, RBIs, hits, wins and ERA. At Clemson University he was the leading home run hitter and member of 3 ACC championship teams and played in the College World Series. Seth was a Division 1 All American and drafted by the Mariners where he played 4 years at the AA level. In basketball he was All Berks and All State in '91 and '92, and was the Berks scoring champ in '92 with a 29.1 average. He ranks 7th in Berks all-time scoring. Seth was also a standout soccer player and All-Berks in golf.



WADE MILLER

After an outstanding athletic career at Brandywine Heights High School and a one year stint at Alvernia, Wade was drafted in 1996 by the Houston Astros. In his rookie season at Alvernia, Wade went 7-1, striking out 77 batters in 55 innings and had an ERA of 2.89. He also batted .397 and helped lead the Crusaders to their first NCAA regional. In the major leagues he pitched 895 innings and had a career record of 62-46 in 147 starts. His best season was in 2001 when he was a 16 game winner for the Astros, followed by 15 wins in 2002 and 14 wins in 2003.Wade had 749 strikeouts in a nine year major league career with the Astros, Red Sox and Cubs. He went on to be the pitching coach for his alma mater Alvernia.



JARRA RUSNOCK DENNIS

At Muhlenberg High School, Jarra earned 12 varsity letters, 4 each in basketball, tennis and softball. She was the Muhls Outstanding Senior Athlete and 1,021 point scorer in basketball. At Albright College, Jarra was also a 4 year letter winner in the same 3 sports and in basketball she set numerous records including single game points, single season points, career points, and foul shooting. She was MAC Rookie of the Year, GTE All Academic All American First Team and MAC silver medalist in tennis. She has served as Muhlenberg High's girls head basketball coach and assistant coach. Jarra is also an outstanding basketball referee at the high school and college levels. Jarra worked the PIAA 6A 2017 Girls State Championship game. Collegiately, she worked the PSAC finals in 2017, 18, 19, 22, and 23 and NCAA D2 Regional playoffs in 2017, 18, 19, 22, 23 and 2023 Atlantic Region final. She was inducted into the Muhlenberg High School, Albright College and Berks County Basketball Sports Halls of Fame.



RICH SCARCELLA

Rich Scarcella has been a sports writer and columnist for the Reading Eagle since 1986. He has covered a variety of high school, college and professional sports and has covered the Penn State football team since 1989. Rich has won many awards in writing contests sponsored by the Football Writers' Association of America, the Associated Press Sports Editors, the Pennsylvania Associated Press Managing Editors and the Pennsylvania NewsMedia Association (Keystone Awards) for event coverage, columns, features and beat reporting. His work also has appeared in Lindy's Sports College Football Preview for three-plus decades and The Sporting News.




JAMES DEVELIN

James is a graduate of Boyertown High School where he had an outstanding career in football and lacrosse. He was named first team All-Berks County and All-Pac in football. He played collegiate football at Brown University and was a National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame Scholar Athlete. He was a 3 time All-Ivy league selection as a defensive end. James went undrafted in the 2013 NFL Draft and eventually was signed as a free agent by the New England Patriots and played 8 seasons in the NFL. He won three Super Bowls with the Patriots and was voted to the NFL Pro Bowl as a fullback in 2017.




FRED WITTICH

Fred was a standout basketball and baseball player for Mt. Penn High School graduating in 1972. He was the leading scorer for the basketball team that won 3 District 3 and Eastern titles and the PIAA Class C State championship in 1971 and 72. He led the county in scoring and was All-Berks first team in 1971 and 72. Fred still holds the Mt. Penn single season and career scoring records (1,495). On the diamond, Fred pitched a no-hitter, and was the second leading hitter in the Legion League. He went on to a stellar two sport career at Elizabethtown College scoring 1217 points in basketball and selected to the MAC All-Star team. Fred has been inducted into the Mt. Penn, Elizabethtown, and Berks County Basketball Halls of Fame.



CHAD HENNE

Chad is a former Wilson High School football player and four year starter at quarterback. His high school athletic accolades include All-State, All-American, and Gatorade Pennsylvania Player of the Year. He was a five-star quarterback recruited by the University of Michigan and started all four years of his career. After his first season, Chad was named to the All-American Freshman team. To end his college career he was named the MVP of the Capital One Bowl. He also received All Big Ten honors his junior and senior seasons. To date, Chad holds all passing records at the University of Michigan. Chad was drafted in the second round of the 2008 draft by the Miami Dolphins, where he played for four years; then moved on to play for the Jacksonville Jaguars for six years. His last stop was with the Kansas City Chiefs, where he spent five seasons. He finished his career going to 6 straight AFC Championship games, and is a two-time Super Bowl champion. After the Chiefs Super Bowl LVII win, Chad announced his retirement to close out a 15 year NFL career.



TIM BRILL (DECEASED)

Tim was an outstanding athlete who graduated from Oley High School in 1973. He scored 1033 points in basketball and led Oley to a county title in soccer where he was an All-State striker. Tim was an All Berks pitcher and was drafted out of high school by the California Angels in the 24th round. Tim chose to attend St. Joseph's University where he played on the baseball team and was selected by the Cleveland Indians in the 21st round of the draft. He had a three-season minor league career with stops at Jersey City, Chattanooga and Savannah. After his playing career, Tim coached the Oley Legion team for three years.



IM ABLE Foundation congratulates Rodger Krause on the 2023 Inspiration Athletic Award

Rodger Krause is an American paratriathlete, who was born in Reading, Pennsylvania. He transitioned from triathlon to paratriathlon as a result of a serious bicycle accident in 1999. The training accident left Rodger with a broken collar bone and damaged spinal cord. He spent months in the hospital and spinal rehabilitation units. After a year of rehabilitation he continued wheelchair exercising until he was introduced to the world of paratriathlon.

Before becoming a paratriathlete Rodger participated in many triathlon events. Following his accident he continued training until 2007 when he was introduced to the handcycle world by Chris Kaag. While his primary focus is triathlon, Rodger is no newcomer to wheelchair racing and handcycling, having competed in many marathons, duathlons and bike races. At age 64, Rodger became the oldest person ever to complete the 2022 Ironman World Championship in the handcycle division.
