



Dear Eagan Civic Arena User,

As we continue to safely have both rinks at the ECA open, the City of Eagan's intention is to successfully plan, educate and implement reasonable health and safety measures to protect you, your athletes, and spectators. During this very challenging time, we want to continue providing an environment that complies with the directives set by the State of MN and the CDC.

Note the following requirements, restrictions, and recommendations. Some will be short-term while others may become routine to our facility. Your cooperation and prior planning as a user of the Civic Arena is greatly appreciated during **Phase 3**.

**Recommendations:**

- ECA social distancing stickers are 6' apart in LR's, bleachers, railings, and benches → please use a reference
- Come dressed (except skates) and bring your own water bottle → exception being goalies
- Drop-off and pick-up → drop-off only for kids 11 or older → 1 parent/guardian permitted per child 10 or younger
- Sanitizing stations will be accessible in both rinks and lobby's → please sanitize your hands upon arrival and departure

**Requirements:**

- **Face coverings are a state mandate for all public indoor spaces - Executive Order 20-81**
  - **One exception being players on the ice**
- Head Coaches/Organizations submit a plan to ECA Management to handle current social distancing guidelines
  - This needs to be submitted prior to your first scheduled ice time → see **User Agreement**
- Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to your scheduled ice time & go straight to your assigned LR's
  - Drop-off and pick-up at the East/West rink lobby's → Doors between rinks will be locked
  - There will be 15-minute gaps before/after each user to limit groups overlapping
- Per our specific facility, our social distancing capacity varies per rink (includes skaters, coaches, spectators)
  - Max of 50 skaters at one time including coaches → 2 pods of 25 (1/2 rink per 25 skaters)
    - Games – 25 total skaters are permitted on the ice when using the entire sheet together
    - Social Distancing Capacity for spectators: East Rink = 36 / West Rink = 104
    - No spitting on the ice, LR's or player benches
    - LR doors will always remain open → please no valuables

**Restrictions:**

- No second level access to Arena → prior approval from ECA Full-Time staff needed
- No pro-shop services → skaters need to have personal equipment ready prior to ice time
- No concessions or vending → we need to limit the number of touchpoints in the Arena
- No dryland activities or rentals → prior approval from ECA Full-Time staff needed

Your social distancing plan will be submitted to me prior to your first scheduled ice time through the **User Agreement** form. Our Phase 3 User Agreement, Readiness Plan and Letter To Users is accessible via our website at [www.eagancivicarena.com](http://www.eagancivicarena.com)
