



Dear Managers, Coaches and Players,

On behalf of everyone at the Peninsula Youth Softball Association (PYSA), thank you for attending our 2025 Cool Breeze All Star Tournament. This year's tournament will feature 68 teams from 18 Southern California All-Star leagues! It should be a fun, exciting weekend of girls fastpitch softball. This link should answer frequently asked questions about the tournament.

All teams must be registered with USA Softball as a recreational "B" or "C" All-Star team. All players must be fully registered in the USA Softball system prior to the tournament, and no player may be on the roster of more than one team. The rules and the game times have not been finalized yet, and I'll send another message when this is finalized!

We would prefer that your teams check in online before the tournament weekend by providing the following information. Please have your team managers email the paperwork and information to pysacoolbreeze@gmail.com. I will confirm receipt and send a message clearing your team for pre-check in.

- 1) USA Softball Official Championship Roster**, with parent/adult signatures.
- 2) The team's USA Softball ID cards (pdf with coaches and players)**, or a screenshot showing your team home page (with checkmarks for background check, Safesport & ACe training, and children's birth certificates).

- 3) **Team or League Proof of Insurance.**
- 4) **A screenshot of two coaches' Concussion certifications.**
- 5) **Contact information for the team's manager (email & cell phone number)**
- 6) **Your team name on Gamechanger**

Alternatively, you may bring copies of these documents to the check-in desk at least 1 hour before your first game for a physical check-in. Please don't provide photos, birth certificates, or other documents we've not asked for.

Even if you complete the online check-in process, please stop by the registration table near the Snack Shack before your first game. At check in, you will receive a **Welcome Packet** that will contain **Cool Breeze Tournament pins** as well as two **Player of the Game Award Medals**. After each of your pool games, you should award the medal to a player from the opposing team after the game on the outfield grass (so that we can get the infield ready for the next game). These medals will only be given out after pool games, not bracket play.

The [Cool Breeze website](#) link has a map of Robb Field showing the fields, parking, PYSA Snack Shack, food trucks and restrooms. Your welcome packet will also include that map. Robb Field is a dog-friendly public park; please keep your furry friends on a leash and make sure to clean up after them. Games will be on fields #1 through #8, and each team will have two pool games on Friday or Saturday, followed by bracket play later Saturday and on Sunday. Championship games will be Sunday.

The 2025 Peninsula Cool Breeze tournament schedule and scores will be posted in Tourney Machine. I will send out the Tourney Machine link once we've completed the schedule and the rules are finalized.

We will be selling Cool Breeze logo wear again this year next to the Snack Shack.

The Snack Shack with a grill will be open every day of the tournament. There will be a coffee cart, taco truck and a Hawaiian shaved ice truck at Robb Field on Saturday & Sunday, and there are several great options for eating nearby in Ocean Beach.
