CODE OF CONDUCT CONTRACT



COACH CODE OF CONDUCT -

1. To abide by the Zero tolerance of abuse to Referees and players
2. To refrain from using profanity
3. To treat each player equally
4. To focus on player development and to place the emotional and physical well-being of players ahead of winning
5. To lead by example with sportsmanship and fair play
6. To provide a safe environment for all players
7. To keep track of players schooling and to ensure they are keeping up their grades

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT -

1. To have soccer be my predominant sport and be ready to participate 4 times a week
2. To train and play to the best of my abilities.
3. Keep a positive attitude.
4. Arrive promptly and ready to go 15 minutes before practices and 45mins before games.
5. Refrain from the use of profanity, both on and off the field.
6. Respect my coaches and teammates, and to only give positive encouragement.
7. Respect my opponents, teammates and referees and to not play in a way that would purposely hurt or injure another player and to accept decisions without argument
8. Accept my team placement.
9. Accept coaching decisions during games but to be brave enough to ask why
10. Exhibit humility when winning and grace when losing.
11. To remember that I represent myself, my team, my club, and my family with my actions, play and comments.
12. To keep up my grades and to realize that if I do not that will affect my playing time on the team
13. To ensure best behavior and effort at school remembering I am representing my family and team at all times

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Help my player to meet all team and club expectations and commitments.
2. Accept the team placement of my player.
3. Be encouraging, supportive and affirmative in regard to all players play on the field
4. Be respectful of ALL referees, players, coaches, and spectators. Parents who do not display appropriate behavior on the sidelines WILL be asked and expected to leave the sidelines.
5. Accept the coach's decisions during games and practices. If concerns arise and you feel you need to speak to a coach please arrange a time that is not during, or directly after a game (24hr rule). Players must be included in any meeting.
6. Make sure that any family or friends that are attending games with you adhere to the policies in regards to acceptable sideline behavior.
7. To keep the coach informed of how my child is doing at school academically and behaviorally
8. Pay or arrange payment options for all player, club or team fees by their due dates. Players cannot play if fees have not be paid

THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR REFEREE OR PLAYER ABUSE

We (parents and players) have read and hereby agree to abide by the CDO Soccer club code of conduct. We also understand that failure to do so is subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination, after discussion with the CDO Board:

- Oral or written warning
- Suspension from practices or games
- Season suspension
- Permanent termination from the team

Note: No reimbursement of fees will be made due to the dismissal of a player from a game or the club for not adhering to this contract as outlined.
