



Peachtree Baseball Umpire Cheat Sheet

The intent of this document is to share all Peachtree specific rules that visiting umpires should be aware of and will need to be responsible for. Rules that is not on the umpire to utilize such as playing time, etc. will not be included.

Majors and Minors

10 run rule in effect after the 4th inning (or 3.5 in the event the visiting team is down).

If there is a play at home, the offensive player must slide. If they do not slide, they will be called out. Umpires judgement surrounding "play at home".

Only head coaches are to converse with an umpire during the game.

You can play with 8 players.

Games have a 2-hour time limit. This is not drop dead. No new inning shall start after the 2 hour mark.

Majors Only

Balks for Major Division

- A) The plate umpire will discuss with both head coaches before the game and let them know what he considers a balk. In the beginning of the season there will be 'flexibility' with calling balks- if there is no advantage gained- no balk will be called. The umpire will warn the coach that a balk has occurred.
- B) Starting the 4th Monday of the season (we will let you know) umpires will be calling balks and the balk ruling will be strictly enforced

Minors Only

6 run max rule per inning. The last inning is unlimited runs. Umpire should strive to work with coaches to announce last inning. This will be a balancing act in the beginning of the year for week day games.
