## BOYS PLAYER SELECTION/DEVELOPMENT CAMP

**Open to players with birth years of 2007, 2008 & 2009**

**“Goalie Only” session April 16 for ALL Goalies of Each birth year**

**April 19-21, 2024 for all players (including Goalies)**

**Schedules may vary for each age group**

**ALL Camp Sessions for Each birth year will be held at the Ice Den – Scottsdale**

Online registration through the AAHA website is required for all participants.

The Arizona Camp will be open to the first **40** Forwards, **24** Defensemen and **10** Goalies per birth years **2008** and **2009** to register online.

The Arizona Camp will be open to the first **33** Forwards, **18** Defensemen and **8** Goalies for birth year **2007** to register online.

**All players must be USA Hockey registered.**

Only US Citizens and permanent residents of the State of Arizona are eligible to be selected for advancement to Rocky Mountain District Player Selection/Development Camps.

This Camp is for players who have demonstrated the necessary skill level and skating ability to warrant consideration of advancement to the next level of USA Hockey’s National Player Development Camp process and is not intended for House Players or those with less than 2 years of experience.

All registered goalies also receive a “Goalies Only” session on April 16<sup>th</sup> at Ice Den Scottsdale in addition to the main Camp ice sessions. If more than **8** goalies per birth year 2008 or 2009 or more than **6** goalies per birth year 2007 register for the Camp, the “Goalies Only” session will be used to reduce the number to **8** goalies per birth year 2008 and 2009 and **6** for birth year 2007 for the Camp sessions with skaters.

Partial refunds of \$100 will be given to any goalie that does not advance to the sessions with skaters.

Each birth year/age group will feature a Head Coach/Evaluator who will be assisted by a minimum of four coaches per birth year/age group. The Head Coaches/Evaluators will be responsible for the on-ice sessions as well as overseeing and having the final word in the selection of players chosen to advance to the next level.

**The cost to attend the 2024 Camp is:**

**\$170.00 per player (including Goalies)**

**Registration for the Camp closes March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024 or sooner if slots are filled**

**The Next Level of Player Selection/Development Camps**

Boys with birth years of 2007, 2008 and 2009, and are US Citizens and permanent residents of the State of Arizona will be eligible to advance to the Rocky Mountain District Player Selection /Development Camp in Dallas, Texas, May 17<sup>th</sup> through May 19<sup>th</sup>. Additional information about the District Camp, including Frequently Asked Questions, will be available shortly on the AAHA website.

For those born in 2010, the Rocky Mountain District, the Pacific District and the Northern Plains District have joined forces to stage the “Western Regional Multi-District High Performance Select 14 Camp” which is similar in structure to a National Camp. More information on this camp and the tryout process will be posted on this web page.
