
## **SCORESHEET**



Here is a copy of the scoresheet (right/left sides) for the Squirt games- I suggest having a scrap sheet of paper next to you when doing scorecard- which you can then transfer the scorecard information. Will need to track shots on goal (Penalty Box worker- job), document when goals were scored (times/ player numbers/assists- which the refs tell you). Team managers will have "stickers" so you don't have to write the rosters/numbers on each page... \*\*\* If recording shots on goal = shots the goalie <u>ACTUALLY</u> stops (not if it hits the cross bar/ not if a defense player knocks it away)- <u>ONLY</u> legit shots the goaltenders actually themselves stopped the play count.
