

## Ice Vault regulations for this weekend's events

These are the protocols to be followed by everyone attending any events this weekend in order for us to be open safely for all of our guests who come in our building. We follow all NJ State and local guidelines as well as CDC recommendations.

1. No one is to enter the building if they have any of the Covid 19 symptoms. That includes, shortness of breath, fever of over 100 degrees, difficulty breathing, coughing, loss of taste, vomiting or diarrhea.
2. Every person entering the building must wear a mask at all times. The only exception to this is when players are on the ice doing a strenuous activity. Whenever a player leaves the ice they must put on a mask immediately. Coaches and supervisors must wear a mask when they are on the bench or the ice.
3. NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED IN THE RINKS. You may watch the game on closed circuit tv outside, in the bar or in the restaurant or outside in the tents.
4. All participants when they are coming to the rinks should be game ready. Minus their helmets and skates. Goalies can dress in the rinks due to their equipment. All others must be ready. There will no locker room assignments. They are not to enter the rink prior to 15 minutes before their event.
5. When an event is over, all participants must exit the rink within 15 minutes.
6. The In the Crease Bar and the Ice Vault Café restaurant are only allowed to operate at 25% of capacity. This is strictly adhered to. No one who enters the Bar or the Café is allowed to stand other than to order food. All guests must be seated at all times.
7. Temperatures are to be taken by the coaches for all participants on the ice. A record will be kept and given to the front office.
8. There will be security in the lobby to insure all guests follow these protocols strictly.
9. There are hand sanitizing stations throughout the building for your safety.

This is a very difficult period of time for all of us. The safety and health is paramount to our organization. Please help us keep your kids on the ice. PLEASE REMEMBER. THIS IS ABOUT THE KIDS AND NOT THE PARENTS. We all know you want to see your kids perform. As soon as State regulations permit it, we will do so.
