## **1868 looks to lock up playoff spot against Tacoma Defiance Reno can secure playoff berth with win or draw**

After a draw at the death on Saturday against Sacramento, Reno 1868 FC returns home for a matchup with Tacoma Defiance that could lock up the playoffs for Reno. With a win or draw, the boys in blue will clinch a top-two spot in Group A and a fourth straight playoff berth.

“We’ve got to handle business at home,” said head coach Ian Russell. “It’s a big game for us, it’s our game in hand. If we can win and get three points it’s going to put us in a really good position.”

Reno enters on a five-game unbeaten streak, thanks to forward Aidan Apodaca’s heroics in the closing seconds of Saturday’s game.

Trailing 3-2 in stoppage time, Apodaca was able to secure a lofted ball from Brent Richards and put a rocket into the back of the net. The draw secured a point on the road for Reno, and kept the lads atop Group A with 25 points.

A win in Sacramento would have clinched a playoff spot, but the draw set up a chance to clinch in front of an empty Greater Nevada Field.

Tacoma enters the match struggling as of late. The Defiance were unbeaten in their first three games after the USL Championship season was restarted in July, before making an August 8 trip to Reno. 1868 came out on top 2-1, and Defiance has yet to win a game since.

All time, Reno has never lost to Tacoma. The club owns a 5-0-3 record against Defiance, one of eight USL clubs to never beat Reno. Of the eight winless opponents, Tacoma has had the most games against Reno as well.

In the sides’ two previous matchups this season, Reno has won 3-1 and 2-1.

The game will be played at Greater Nevada Field, where Los Azules have seen plenty of success in 2020. In Reno’s five home games this season, the team has gone 5-1-0 and averages 3.2 goals per game compared to 2.8 on the road. The last time out at GNF saw Reno put up seven goals against Portland Timbers 2.









Leading the way for Los Azules has been an electric stretch of games from forward Foster Langsdorf. Langsdorf has scored in five straight games, bringing his goal total to a team-leading six. The five game streak is the second-longest in club history, behind Dane Kelly’s six-game streak from 2017.

Kickoff is set for 6:30 p.m. PT from Greater Nevada Field. The game will be broadcast live on ESPN+, Nevada Sports Net and ESPN Radio 94.5. **2020 Outlook:** Reno's all-time leader in games (89) and starts (87) returns in 2020 for his fourth season with 1868 FC. Richards is fourth all-time in club history with 13 assists, leading all active players. The Portland native has served as captain for 11 games, and is poised to be a crucial piece on and off the pitch in 2020.

**2019 (Reno 1868 FC):** Richards tallied five assists, tied for fifth on the team ... Started 31 games ... Was one of just three players to serve as captain on the season, wearing the armband in 11 matches ... Earned USL Team of the Week honors in week 28 after a club-record three assists in a 5-0 win over Tacoma ... The three assists marked a career and club best ... Richards' 13 career assists are tied for fourth-most in club history, leading all active 1868 players ... Leads the club in career games played (89) and starts (87) ... In 1868 history, only three players have been named captain more than Richards.

**2018 (Reno 1868 FC):** Appeared in 33 games, starting 29 ... Tallied four assists on the season, tied for third on the team ... Led the club in blocks (16), interceptions (73) and tackles (51), and was second in clearances with 122 ... Finished third on the team in passes with 1,243, and led the team in minutes with 2,696 ... Started both playoff games, including the first playoff win in club history.

**2020 Outlook:** Corey Hertzog comes back to Reno after a historic first season with 1868 FC in 2019. Hertzog posted career highs in goals (19) and assists (6). Hertzog's 19 goals broke Brian Brown's 1868 FC single-season record of 18 from 2018. The veteran forward will lead the attack for Los Azules in 2020.

After just one season, Hertzog is already second all-time in goals with Reno, trailing Brian Brown's 28 from 2017-19 ... Hertzog's 19 goals are the most in a single season in club history ... His six assists were tied for fifth-most in a single season in club history, and already are the ninth-most in club history ... The 19 goals finished tied for third in the USL, and second in the Western Conference behind MVP and Golden Boot Winner Solomon Asante ... Scored two goals on three separate occasions, including a 3-0 road win over Tulsa to cap the regular season ... Joined Brian Brown as just the second player to score for Reno in the USL playoffs ... Led the club in shots with 79, the second most in club history.

**Previous:** The veteran forward boasts 64 goals and 18 assists in the 155 appearances of his USL career ... In 2018, he recorded four goals and three assists in 26 appearances for Saint Louis FC ... He added to his career with 12 appearances in MLS for the Vancouver Whitecaps where he recorded one goal and had one assist.

# IAN RUSSELL

## HEAD COACH

Fourth year

Ian Russell returns to Reno for his fourth season at the helm of 1868 FC after a record-breaking 2019 to cap the best three-year start in USL history. Russell has been a finalist for USL Coach of the Year twice, and owns 52 wins with Reno. Russell was named a finalist for USL Coach of the year in 2019, as voted on by his fellow USL coaching staffs.

In 2019, Russell guided Reno to 18 wins and 60 points, both club records. Reno's September 20th win in New Mexico not only clinched the club's third straight trip to the playoffs, only five other clubs have made playoffs in each of their first three seasons, it was Russell's 50th total USL win.

Just under a month later, Reno would top Tulsa to earn Russell his 51st regular-season win. The mark is the most regular-season wins for a coach's first three seasons with a new club in the USL.

2019 included forward Corey Hertzog earning All-League second team honors, bouncing back from a down 2018 season to set career highs in goals and assists in his first year with the club.

In 2017, Russell's first year in Reno, forward Dane Kelly earned the league MVP award, the golden boot and a spot on the All-League first team. Joining him on the All-League first team was midfielder Chris Wehan, the league's assist leader and rookie of the year. That year, defender Jimmy Ockford earned All-League second team honors as well. After the season, Russell was a finalist for Coach of the Year, finishing third in the voting.

Russell began his coaching career in 2008 with the Earthquakes as an assistant coach, a position he held for eight seasons. He helped lead the club to the postseason twice, while earning the Supporters' Shield for best regular season record (19-6-9) in 2012. Russell was also instrumental in the Quakes' international and collegiate scouting efforts, and briefly helped oversee the club's youth development as the academy's technical director. He served as the Earthquakes interim head coach for the final two games of the 2014 season and holds a U.S. Soccer Federation "A" coaching license.
