#### A. Executive Updates

- i. President Dana Savoie

- Parent Survey Next steps
  - Work continues on getting the Parent Survey out to members. The newly appointed Registrar Support position will take over responsibility for this in the coming weeks.
- MN Hockey Conference Update
  - 18,804 Minnesota youth hockey players participated in association hockey last year. The MN Hockey program is 40% larger than any other state in the nation. Each year Minnesota adds 8,000 new hockey players which stays consistent with the number of players who move, age out, etc.
  - o 2019-2020 MN Hockey rule change summary of note:
    - 30-day suspension if a coach is on the ice without a helmet.
    - Match Penalty (Intent to Injure): Immediate suspension until a hearing is completed through the local association, but D6 and MN Hockey must be informed of and potentially participate in the hearing.
