President Shawn expressed appreciation to the attendees for their participation in the format now utilized by the Affiliate: Most of 88 89 the time at the meeting site is applied to education and interaction, followed by the much shorter formal Annual Meeting. He emphasized that readers seeking 90 91 guidance for the conduct of youth hockey activities within the Affiliate should refer 92 to postings on the MWAHA website, beginning with 'Policies & Procedures'. 93 He offered as rules of engagement for today's meeting that we be brief and 94 considerate. 95 96 Minutes. 97 Minutes of the Annual Meeting held June 17<sup>th</sup> 2017 were reviewed. 98 Motion 99 That the minutes be approved as presented. 100 Passed by acclamation.

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#### 102 Elections.

President Shawn turned the gavel over to Vice President Brad Parker to conduct the election of 'even year officers'. In the normal rotation of Executive Committee positions, the President, the 'even year' Vice President, and the Secretary were up for election. The Incumbents (Shawn Spencer, Chris Schmale, and John Shelton) have expressed desire to continue to serve. VP Brad noted no other nominations had been received and solicited nominations from the floor. In the absence of other nominations.

President Shawn commented that we truly do need to bring more and more people up through volunteer positions to increase our depth of talent and provide for orderly succession.

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## Compliance.

- 119 Vice President Todd Larsen discussed compliance protocol as delineated in the 120 Policy & Procedures, highlighting the documentation that is requested annually or upon changes. By way of example (but not limitation): a copy of by laws and travel policy, EIN, and a statement that the association is in compliance with IRS 122 123 regulations and not under notice of any issue. The Affiliate wants to have the 124 paperwork done by September 1st.
- 125 He emphasized that there are consequences for non compliance, not the least of 126 which is \$250 for not attending the annual meeting.

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## President's State of the Association and USAH Summer Congress.

- 129 President Shawn reported the USAH Summer Congress which occurred the week 130 prior. He described the awards and notable accomplishments.
- 131 He reviewed the goals the Affiliate is leaning toward, including governance (PnP), 132 associations to benefit coaches and officials, and unclaimed members, and 133 onerously progressive coaching requirements.
