OPEN GYMS:

Open gyms are voluntary but are highly recommended for players to prepare for the upcoming high school season. They will consist of drills for skill training as well as competitive situations. New this year, because of the new district policy, these will be open to players entering grades 7-12 in the fall of 2024.

This is the Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) Summer Waiver Blackout Window. During this time, players may continue to train by lifting, attending camps or private lessons, but these may not involve any of the CPVB coaching staff.

TRYOUTS:

The tryout process will begin on Monday, August 12th and conclude on Wednesday, August 14th. If necessary, cuts will be made throughout the process and players will know their team and role by the end of the day on the 14th at the latest. Players should not plan anything prior to 5:00p each day until teams and schedules are finalized. Tryouts and most team practices will consist of two practices per day.

Missing any part of the tryout process will affect team placement as there will not be any make-up for time missed. All family trips, birthday parties, State Fair, etc. should be scheduled before tryouts or around the practice schedule

Recently, the Anoka-Hennepin School District made a policy change that allows 7th and 8th graders to tryout for high school teams. There are some guidelines that are being finalized and we will pass those along when they are completed.
