

Player Code of Conduct – TWHS Men’s Lacrosse

The Woodlands Men’s Lacrosse Club expects players to conduct themselves in a manner that positively represents The Club, The Community and The Game of Lacrosse.

The following guidelines represent the minimum expectations for all club activities including:

- Before, during, and after practices and games either at the fields or in the surrounding area including the parking lots.
- Same for any club organized events such as dinners, meetings and activities.
- The entire time from departure to return during out of town trips including spring break.
- In addition: Should players receive disciplinary action for serious conduct violations away from the club (i.e. drugs at school, DWI...) then the club may also act.

Rules:

- Maintain high standards of courtesy, kindness, morality, honesty, and respect to coaches, parents, teammates, officials, and opposing players.
- Always conduct yourself in a sportsmanlike manner on and off the field.
- Adhere to all rules/policies established by coaches, UIL, Conroe ISD and/or facilities being visited.
- All players are subject to UIL eligibility rules, "no pass/no play".
- Refrain from the use of profanity or indecent language.
- Do not use or be in possession of any type of tobacco, illegal drugs, non-prescribed medications, alcohol and/or vaping/juuling paraphernalia. Coaches and/or chaperones have the right to check rooms, bags &/or pockets at any time.
- Do not participate in unlawful, violent or destructive acts nor engage in loud and disruptive behavior.
- Do not wear improper/inappropriate clothing in public.
- During out of town trips, all players must be in their rooms by curfew. No player may leave the team location without explicit permission from a coach or chaperone.
- Language and behavior (verbal, non-verbal, written) should be respectful of diverse social identities, to include: race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, disability, and socioeconomic status.

Consequences:

- Player discipline is subject to the discretion of the coaches and board and may result in reduced playing time, suspension and/or dismissal from the team. Offending players may be sent home at any time at the discretion of the coaches and board and at their expense. • Serious cases will be reviewed independently by the board and coaches.
- The coaching staff and board members reserve the right to request drug or alcohol testing (at the club’s expense and choice of facility) of any player when there is probable cause of policy violation. Failure to complete the requested tests will be considered the same as a test failure.
