Thank you for participating in this year's Arden Berg Jamboree! We know a lot has changed and we are fortunate to have kids on the ice playing. Due to COVID we are not having the raffles or give a-ways like usual. We feel that getting kids on the ice playing is more important! Not only is there a Hockey Jamboree happening this weekend, but also other fun family activities for your team! Please see the below information on Jamboree Rules and other important information.

Rules are as follows:

- Games are listed in Central Time.
- First team listed will be considered the home team and wear light jerseys if they have them.
- Each game will end with a 5 player per team shoot out. This is for fun. Please make sure everyone has a chance!
- Every team will be guaranteed three games
- 2x 20-minute run time periods will be played, buzzer every 2 minutes
- 5 minute warm up prior to start of game and a 3 minute rest between periods.
- The ice will be resurfaced after every two games unless determined otherwise.
- All players from BOTH teams will tag up at the wall before the next group of players Goes.
- Goalies and intermediate nets will be used.
- Traditional half ice play for all 3 games and teams will share a player's bench.
- Coaches can decide if you will play 4x4 or 5x5 depending on roster size.
- When a goal is scored, or the goalie covers the puck the opposing team will back out and play will continue.
- If a player is issued a penalty they will go to their bench and their team will be short-handed for the remainder of the shift.
- Teams will keep the same nets for both periods.
- If the puck goes out of play the ref will toss a new puck into play.
- We will not be keeping track of scores.
- Teams will receive locker assignments upon arriving at the rink. We will be putting two teams from the same organization together in a locker rooms (Example Watford 1 and Watford 2 will share a locker room).
- No sharing of water bottles. Please bring a separate water bottle for each player and have it clearly identified!

Additional information:

- The Watford City Parks and Recreation Department and the Rough Rider Center (RRC) will also be hosting activities in the area.
- The RRC pool will be open, as well as bounce houses and other fun activities in the field house.
- On January 15 & 16 there will be the Hartigan Motorsports Battle At the Barn Go-kart Racing happening at the McKenzie County Fairgrounds.

- We encourage our teams to spend the night in Watford as there are a lot of fun activities for the entire family!
