



BHS LUMBERJACK FIELD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



Bemidji High School does not have a competitive football, soccer, or baseball field. The Bemidji High School Lumberjack Field Improvement Project Fund has been formed by a group of local supporters to address the needs of the BHS teams. It is a component fund of the Northwest Minnesota Foundation.

Phase 1

- *Strip and redo the surface of the track and move the field events to one area at the east end of the track
- *Build a game ready soccer field complete with scoreboard, lights that will also illuminate a portion of the track/football field, and home and away bleachers
- *Build 2 soccer practice fields

Phase 2

- *The addition of 2 softball fields complete with scoreboard for the JV field and fencing.
- *Move the existing soccer fields in back to north and south instead of east/west
- *Scoreboard at Sagedahl field
- *Trail head at the cross country/Nordic ski trail

Phase 3

- *Stadium with synthetic turf for football that will also be marked for soccer and softball. It will be complete with scoreboard, lights, bleachers, fencing, and storage area
