

14th Annual Presidents' Day Classic *February 14-17, 2020*



Game Format:

10U Divisions

Three periods, each 12 minutes in length with stop clock

12U, 14U, 16U, 19U Divisions

Three periods, each 15 minutes in length with stop clock

Penalties: Penalties: Minor: 1:30 minutes Penalties: Minor: 2:00 minutes

Major: 5:00 minutes Misconduct: 10:00 minutes

Any player who receives a major penalty under the guidelines of USA Hockey rules, i.e., fighting, spearing, kicking, etc. will automatically be ejected from the game in which the infraction occurs, plus the next game. In the event the major penalty occurs during the player's last game, the Tournament coordinators will notify his team's respective league for further ruling.

Additional Rules:

- Any player receiving a total of 4 penalties in a game will be ejected from that game.
- Any team receiving a total of 15 penalties will have their coach suspended for the next game.
- All players are required to wear an internal mouth guard during play. Failure to wear it will result in a penalty.

Regulations:

- All games will start following a **2 minute** warm-up. This will ensure that all games start and end on time. If the game scheduled before yours ends early, you must be prepared to start yours at **least 30 minutes** before your schedule start time.
- There is one time out per team per game in this tournament.
- There is no red line. Two line passes are legal. The red line is used for icing purposes only.
- In the event of a 6-goal spread going into the 3rd, or at any time during the 3rd period, the clock will be running time. If the spread goes to less than six goals, then the clock will go back to stop time.

Point Structure: 2 points for a Win - 1 point for a Tie

In the event of a tie by 2 teams, the following tiebreaker will apply:

- 1. Points
- 2. Wins
- 3. Head to Head (This tie breaker does not apply if more than two teams are tied)
- 4. Highest Goal Quotient (Goals for divided by goals against) Highest percentage moves on.
- 5. Fewest penalty minutes
- 6. Coin Toss

Consolation games can end in tie. All playoff games play until winner with rules as follows.

Overtime in Championship Rounds

If the teams are still tied at the end of regulation play, overtime will be played to declare a winner.

- 1. Overtime will be 3 on 3 in period lengths of 5 minutes.
- 2. Penalties: Offending team will place man in the penalty box. Non offending team will add 1 skater (power play 4 on 3).
- 3. When the penalty has expired, the penalized player will rejoin the play and both sides will play 4 on 4 until a stoppage in
- 4. Teams will return to 3 on 3 at the first stoppage of play.
- 5. After 5 minute overtime teams play 5 player shootout until winner is declared.

Coaches and Managers

You are responsible to control your players and parents to ensure that each game is played safely, with no vulgar language or harmful infractions displayed. Team management is responsible for any damages caused by their kids to Arena facilities.
