



JAM HOPS COVID-19 STUDENT PROTOCOL

SIGNS/SYMPTOMS

YOUR CHILD IS EXPERIENCING SYMPTOMS RELATED TO COVID-19

CONTACT US

We must document every case

ISOLATE

Follow MDH guidelines and keep your child home for at least 10 days

NEGATIVE TEST

Child tested for Covid-19 and had a negative test result or received an alternative diagnosis

POSITIVE TEST

Child tested for Covid-19 and had a positive test result

BACK TO JAM HOPS

POSITIVE TEST

YOUR CHILD OR SOMEONE YOUR CHILD HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITH IN THE PAST 48 HOURS HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

CHILD

Child tested positive for Covid-19

CLOSE CONTACT

Someone your child had close contact with tested positive

CONTACT US

We must document every case

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ISOLATE

A positive test means your child should follow MDH guidelines and must stay home for 10 days from start of symptoms until symptoms improve and no fever for 24 hours

QUARANTINE

If a close contact has tested positive for Covid-19 they must stay home for 14 days from last day of close contact

CONTACTS NOTIFIED

All close contacts in associated classes will be notified of possible exposure to Covid-19

BACK TO JAM HOPS

Your child may return to Jam Hops if they have not developed any symptoms within those 14 days

BACK TO JAM HOPS

After 10 days and at least 24 hours of no fever and improved symptoms your child may return to Jam Hops

POSSIBLE EXPOSURE

YOUR CHILD HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITHIN THE LAST 48 HOURS WITH SOMEONE EXPERIENCING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS.

CONTACT US

We must document every case

If the person your child had close contact with gets tested:

If the person your child had close contact with doesn't get tested:

POSITIVE TEST

The close contact of your child tested positive for Covid-19

NEGATIVE TEST

The close contact tested negative for Covid-19 or received an alternative diagnosis

STAY HOME

Keep your child home for 14 days from last day of close contact and monitor symptoms

BACK TO JAM HOPS

CLOSE CONTACT: Someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period* starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to test specimen collection) until the time the patient is isolated.* Individual exposures added together over a 24-hour period (e.g., three 5-minute exposures for a total of 15 minutes).
