# **Divisions**

Weight classes in all divisions EXCEPT the Heartland division may be combined at tourney directors' discretion to maximize competition.

The intention of the 6-U, 8-U, and 10-U divisions set apart from the Heartland Division is to encourage beginner and developing wrestlers to come and be a part of this growing event. However, in order to qualify for SDUSAW's top two teams, wrestlers must compete in the Heartland Division. Wrestlers in the developmental divisions will be the first wrestlers considered when putting together developmental teams for the Heartland Elementary Dual event.

## <u>6-U</u>

Age: Born 2013 or later

Weight Classes: 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 65+ (10-pound max difference)

Time periods - All Matches - 1-1-1

## 8-U

Age: Born 2011-2012

Weight Classes: 43, 45, 49, 53, 56, 62, 70, 85, 85+ (15 lbs. max difference)

Time periods - (same for championship and consolation) - 1-1-1

#### 10-U

Age: Born 2009-2010

Weight Classes: 49, 53, 56, 59, 63, 67, 71, 77, 84, 93, 105, 120, 120+ (20 lbs. max difference)

Time periods (same for championship and consolation): 1:30-1:30-1:30

**Age:** This event is for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th graders. A wrestler cannot be in this event if he or she is 14 years old or older.

Weight Classes: 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 100, 105, 112, 120, 130, 140 and 160.
