I. State Chair Call to Order (Kelsey)

1. Meeting called to order at 8:18 p.m.
2. In attendance: Kelsey Kottek, Molly Gill, Lynn McCaffrey, Cassandra Rowell, Julia Eagen, and Guest: Debbie Anderson (NAWGJ)  
Virtually: Khumbalani Moyo, Heidi Fogarty, Denise Nontavarnint, and Drew Grow.

II. Financials

- USA Gymnastics was unable to supply a financial spreadsheet but our account stands at \$21,765.
- The committee discussed ideas on how to spend our funds via clinics to bring our coaches and judges together.
- Drew is going to look into a site to host a summer training camp for coaches along with a western/national qualifier training camp.

III. Items for Discussion:

1. Licensed vendor program and new logo updates:
  - Vendors being used by Championship meet hosts must be on the USA Gymnastics approved list.
  - USA Gymnastics has developed a new logo and that should be used for all publications for state meets.
2. Petitions and skipping levels:
  - The committee discussed their concern for individuals being able to compete Gold Xcel and then petition to Level 6 DP in an attempt to skip Level 5 DP.
  - The committee decided they would take it case by case and bring concerns to the National level to consider what this could potentially mean for the DP program.
  - The committee approved the one petition that was on the table from Flightschool.
3. Westerns/Nationals training clinic for qualifiers:
  - Drew will pick a date and send out a save the date.
4. Kelsey shared thoughts and concerns that she had received from various coaches/gym owners.
5. The committee discussed the list of available judges for championship meets:
  - voting sheets were passed out for those on the committee who were eligible to vote.
  - The committee finalized their choices for Optional State, Xcel State, and

Compulsory state.

- **Drew made a motion for 8 judges for Level 6/7 state meet with 1 standing meet ref. Julie 2nd - motion passed.**
6. Apparel changes for level 9/10 and the need for clubs to pay a fee this year.
    - **Julie motioned for the state committee funds to pay ½ of the apparel fee; Heidi 2nd - motion passed.**
  7. Head Tax discussion:
    - USA Gymnastics is no longer supplying rebates to state offices.
    - The committee decided that this was not a great impact on our state office and we would not be making a change to our head tax at this time.
  8. Thoughts on summer camps/clinics/fundraisers
    - This discussion occurred in conjunction with the discussion of state finances.
