

2019 PERSONAL EQUIPMENT POLICY AND WAIVER

PURPOSE:

Kennewick Grid Kids Football permits the use of personal safety equipment purchased for individual use. The personal equipment policy and waiver provides a guideline for allowed personal equipment to ensure the safety of all KGK players.

AUTHORITY:

Article 13 of the Kennewick Grid Kids Football bylaws provides guidance for the use of personal safety equipment. The article gives final authority for approval or denial of personal safety equipment to the Equipment Manager and President.

PERSONAL EQUIPMENT STANDARDS:

All personal safety equipment must meet the guidelines outlined below:

Helmets

- Must meet NOCSAE standards
- · Professionally certified or purchased (with receipt) within the past year
- Manufactured within the past 10 years
- White shells only may not be painted, professional wrap acceptable
- . Fit and condition verified and approved by designated KGK representative (designation made by executive committee)

Facemasks

- · Must meet NFHS standards
- · Protected vision style no open facemasks
- · Gray only approved color
- Verified and approved by designated KGK representative (designation made by executive committee)

Shoulder Pads

- Must meet NOCSAE standards
- Fit verified and approved by designated KGK representative (designation made by executive committee)

Padded Pants

- · Integrated pad styles only
- May not deviate from team colors or style
- Fit verified and approved by designated KGK representative (designation made by executive committee)

REPLACEMENT PARTS OR ACCESSORIES:

If the player is provided his/her own personal safety equipment, the parent/legal guardian is responsible for all replacement parts and accessories. Kennewick grid kids will no supply any clips, straps, belts, or other accessories for any reason.

DOCUMENTATION:

All personal safety equipment use must be documented using the waiver form on the reverse side of this sheet. Waivers must be signed off on by two of the following: president, equipment manager, player safety coordinator. The executive committee may appoint designees in the absence of any of the preceding. A copy of the waiver will be kept in the equipment binder in the KGK office with a photograph of the approved equipment attached.

LIABILITY RELEASE:

By applying for a personal safety equipment waiver, the parent/legal guardian agrees to release Kennewick Grid Kids Football and their designees from all liability for damage or injury resulting from the use of personal safety equipment.
