



Milwaukee Winter Club-Cahill Square Park Community Ice Rink Covid-19 Protocols

Cahill Community Ice Rink is operated by Milwaukee Winter Club in partnership with the Village of Whitefish Bay. Here are the established Covid-19 protocols for players, coaches, and spectators.

MASKS MUST BE WORN by all players, coaches, officials, and spectators always, including on the ice. ONLY 2 Spectators per player will be allowed. Both will be enforced by Rink staff as well as MWC coaches and managers. Bauer Bubble mask with splash guards attached and the CCM game on mask are adequate.

If you or anyone in your family is sick and or been in close contact with someone with Covid-19, stay home and don't come to the rink.

General:

1. Warming house will be closed except for Rink personnel and Officials for games.
2. Bathrooms will be open and accessible from outside.
3. Keep out of all off limit areas. Anyone in a off limit area will be asked to leave the area and the game could be paused. Spectators are allowed only on the North end (parking lot) and West side (warming house side) of the rink. If spectators go outside these areas, the game could be paused and or cancelled. These areas are off limits to protect essential equipment and keep people safe.
4. Spectators will not be allowed into the rink area until all players have accessed the ice and or players benches. There are no bleachers, standing only and all spectators (limit 2 per player) must follow social distancing of 6 feet.
5. All Players should provide their own water bottles. There is not an area to fill water bottles so ensure you bring them filled.
6. No food and Drink allowed in the rink area (coffee mugs, water bottles ok, no alcohol at all is allowed within the park).
7. Players, Coaches and Volunteers must walk/skate across the ice to access the players, penalty, and scorekeeper boxes.

Arriving to the Rink:

1. Do not arrive until **15 minutes prior** to the start of your game. Players will not be allowed into the rink area until previous teams have cleared out. Goalies may be allowed into the rink area 20 minutes prior to game time to dress as they cannot fully dress.
2. Parking is available in the park parking lot and if that is full then street parking is available. Do not park where no parking signs are posted.

3. As there will not be lockers or warming house use for players it is recommended that they arrive fully dressed with the exception of Helmet, Gloves and Skates. They will be outside, so on cold days it will be beneficial to have walking skate guards and come with skates on.
4. There is an area inside the rink area for players to put on their skates and remaining equipment. There are cut logs one for each player. Only players and coaches will be allowed into this area until players have accessed the ice and or players benches. Home team North half (closest to the parking lot) and Visiting Team South half (closest to Zamboni tent).
