



Fairfield Athletic Club Facility Policies

Code of Conduct: All visitors, residents or non-residents are required to comply with the Code of Conduct and all rules at the Fairfield Village recreational facilities. Fairfield Village does not permit disrespectful conduct towards members, guests, employees, or vendors including but not limited to profane, indecent, offensive, violent, provocative, aggressive, harassing language and behavior, or other inappropriate conduct.

Prohibited Items:

- Guns or weapons of any kind, concealed or open carry
- Illegal drugs and paraphernalia
- Alcohol
- Glass containers
- Tobacco products of any kind
- Electronic Cigarette and Vaporizers
- Pets and animals (other than registered and leashed Service Dogs)
- Other items as determined by facility management

Parking: All vehicles must park in a designated parking space within the main lot. Vehicles should not impede any entrances, sidewalks, gates, or garbage receptacles at the facility.

Vehicles are prohibited from parking in the half-circle in front of the facility, along with any red fire lane curbs, or no parking zones. Vehicles parked in prohibited spaces are subject to towing and/or ticketing.

FAC Facility Rules:

1. **The courts will open five minutes prior to practice/game time. Please refrain from entering the FAC before this time.** Due to limited space, childcare, and residents utilizing the facility we cannot accommodate people in the entrance or hallways. If you do arrive early, please wait in your vehicle. Please do not block the front door of the facility.
2. **The childcare hallway (right hallway upon entering the building) is off limits until 6:30pm.** If you need to use the restroom, please utilize the locker rooms at the back of the club. See the front desk for access if you are a non-resident.
3. Absolutely no bouncing balls in the hallways or entrance.
4. Please control noise levels in the facility. The FAC front desk needs to be able to answer phone calls and talk to customers at the desk.
5. No food or drinks (except water) on the courts.
6. All visitors are required to dispose of trash in reciprocal directly outside of the court.
7. Children not participating in FSA sports programs must be supervised by a responsible adult.
