Chairman

The Chairperson shall be the chief executive officer of the corporation. The Chairperson shall preside at all open and special meetings and shall chair all Board of Directors meetings. He shall be the principle executive officer of the corporation. He shall assure that operation of the corporation is in compliance with these By-Laws, shall oversee the consistent application of the Policies and Procedures of the corporation, and shall be responsible for carrying out the decisions of the G. A. W. A. membership and Executive Board. The Chairperson shall also perform such duties as may be assigned by the Executive Board and shall provide an annual 'state of the corporation' report to the membership at the annual Fall Business Meeting.

First and Second Vice Chairpersons

The Vice Chairpersons shall assist the Chairperson and shall serve in his absence. The First & Second Vice Chairperson shall also perform such duties as may be assigned by the Executive Board.

Secretary

The Secretary shall record and publish minutes of each Board of Directors meeting and general or open meetings. The Secretary shall assist with documenting and publishing all of the Policies and Procedures of the corporation, assist the Chairperson with the corporation correspondence, and shall keep required incorporation documentation current with the Georgia Secretary of State's office. The Secretary shall also perform other such duties as may be assigned by the Executive Board.

Treasurer

The Treasurer shall be the chief financial officer of the corporation. He shall maintain the corporate checkbook, credit card accounts, and other appropriate corporate financial records. The Treasurer shall meet the financial obligations of the corporation and make timely payment of appropriate fees to USA Wrestling. He will assure continuation of the tax-free status of the corporation and will file an annual income tax return to that effect with the IRS. He/She will provide a detailed report on income/expenditures, as well as capital assets, at the annual Fall Business Meeting. The Treasurer shall also perform other such duties as may be assigned by the Executive Board.

Registration Chairperson

The Registration Chairperson shall be the primary officer in charge of registering and collecting fees from club and individual members of the G. A. W. A. The Registration chairperson shall obtain and distribute as appropriate all club and individual registration materials and shall provide necessary documentation to USA Wrestling as required. He will provide a detailed report on membership at the annual Fall Business Meeting. The Registration Chairperson shall also perform other such duties as may be assigned by the Executive Board.

USWOA Liaison

The USAWOA Liaison shall act as the primary liaison between the USWOA officials' organization and the G.A.W.A. The purpose of this position is to ensure that the G.A.W.A. proactively considers the needs and requirements of officials in every program offered, so that by the time new programs are offered, official's requirements have been considered as well.

The Women's Wrestling Director shall work to develop and grow Women's wrestling at all levels of the organization. 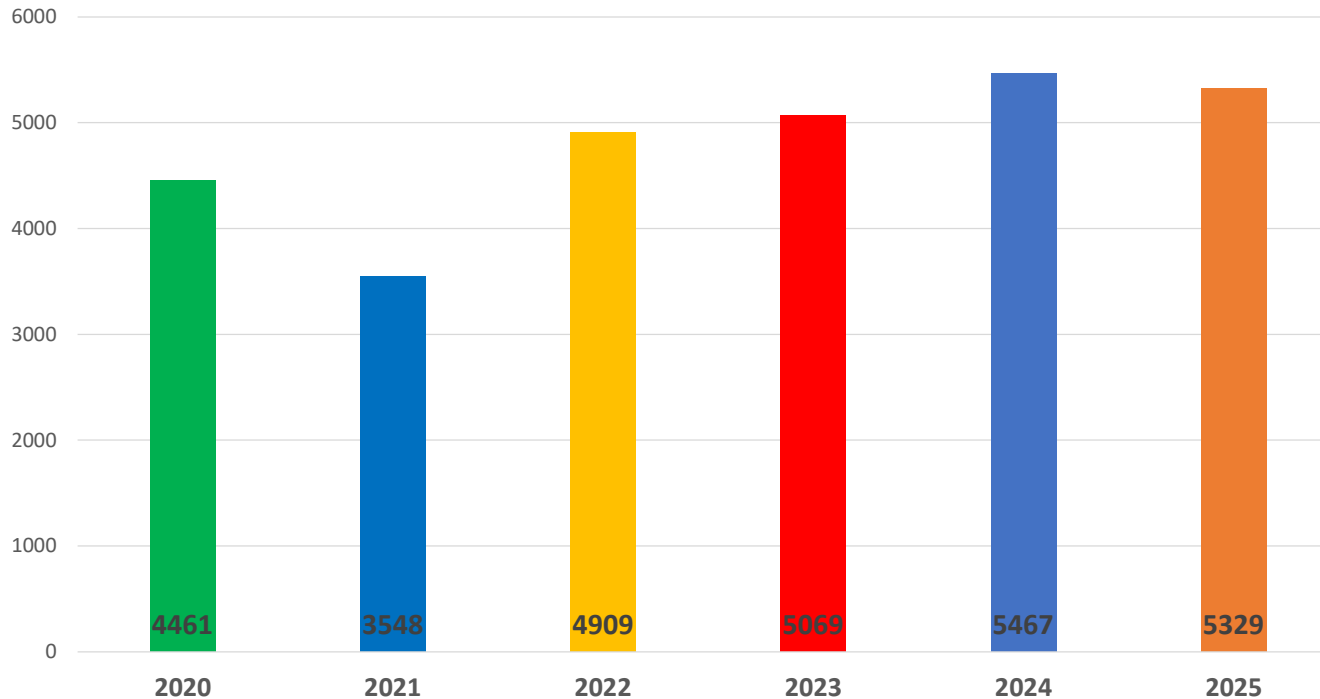

Membership was down 2.5% From Previous Year / 55% New Athletes

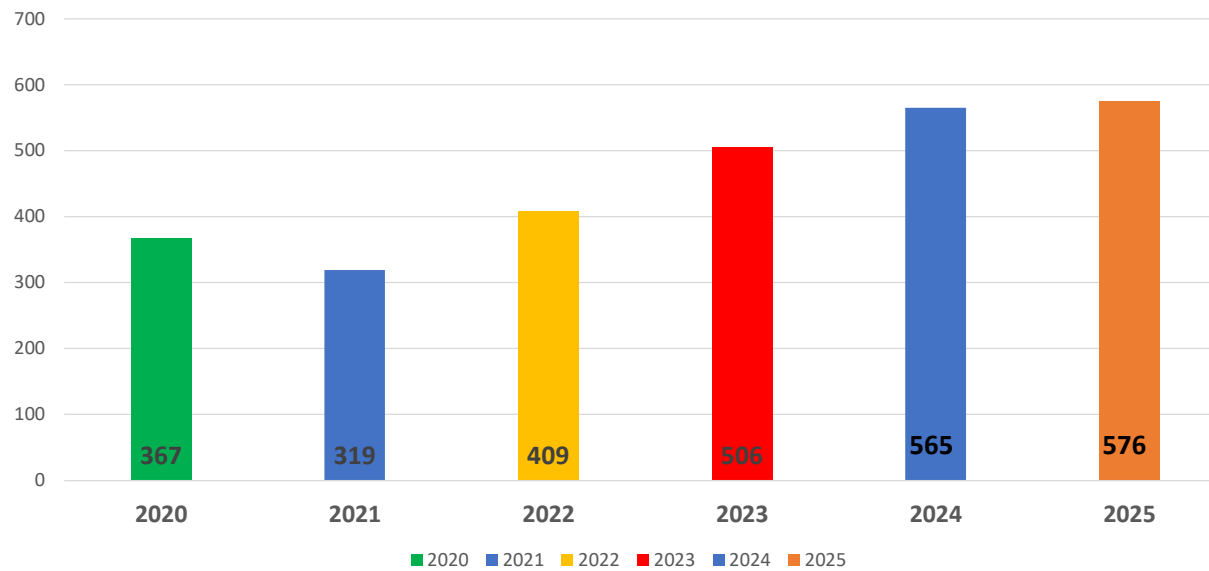

Female Memberships was up 1.95% From Previous Year

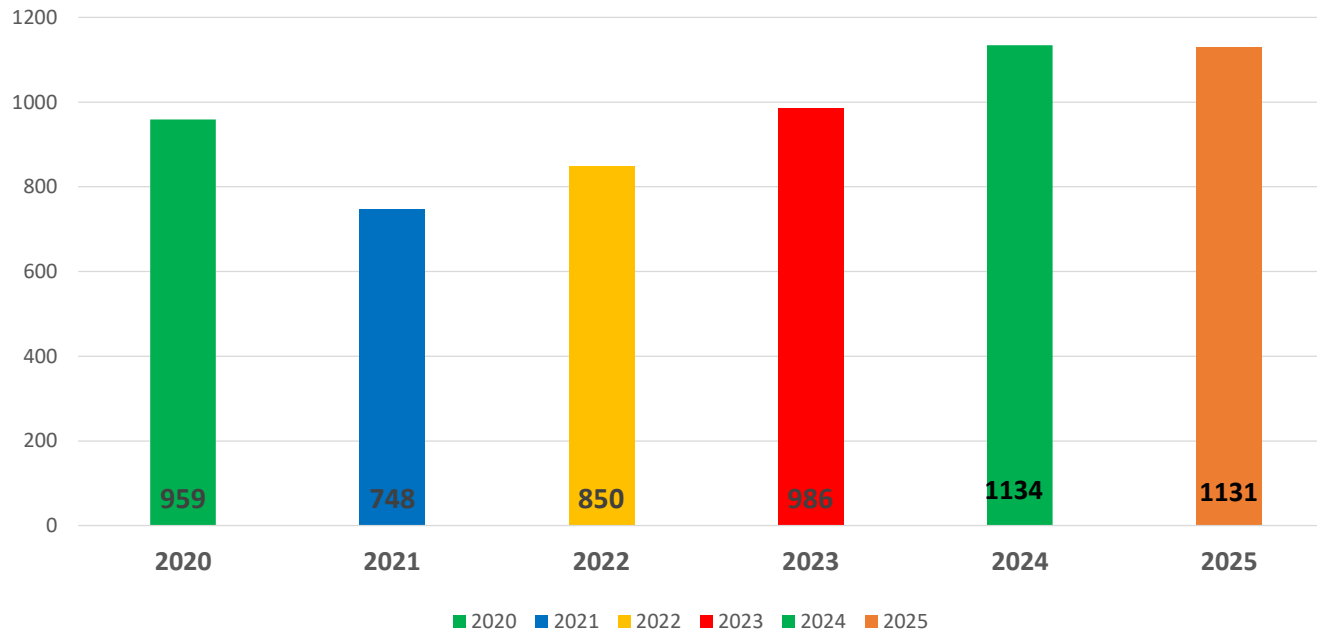

Leadership Cards are about the same from Previous Year

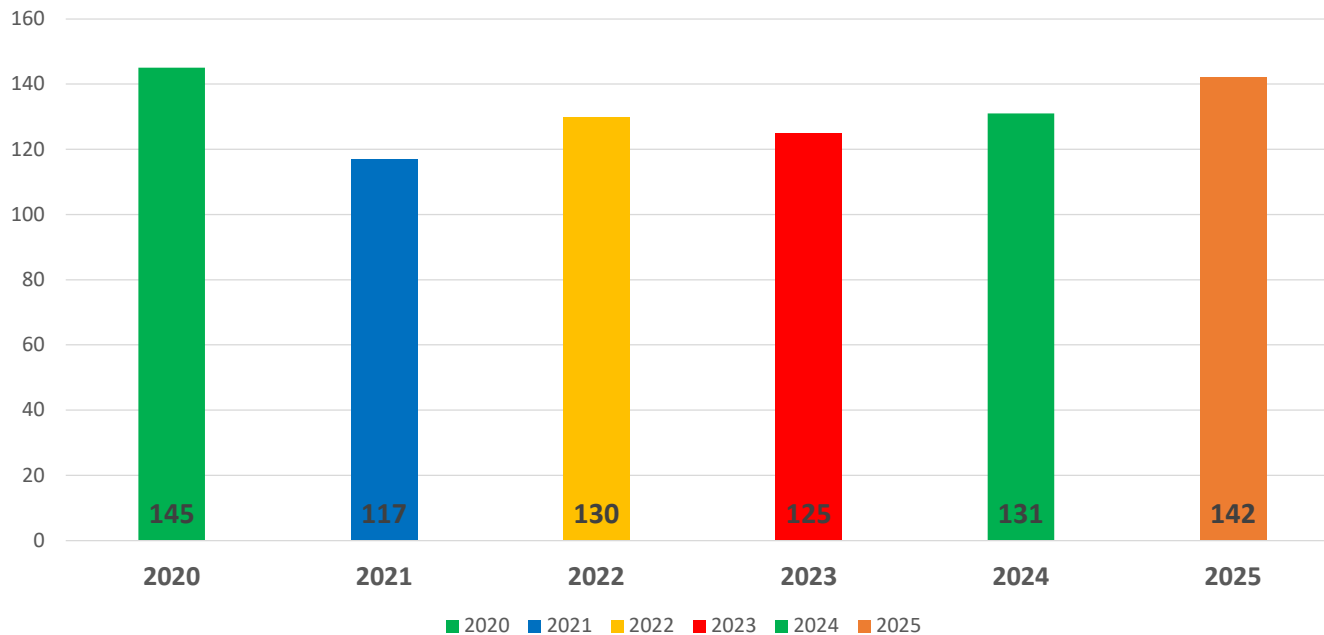

Chartered Clubs were up 8.4% From Previous Year | 22% New Clubs

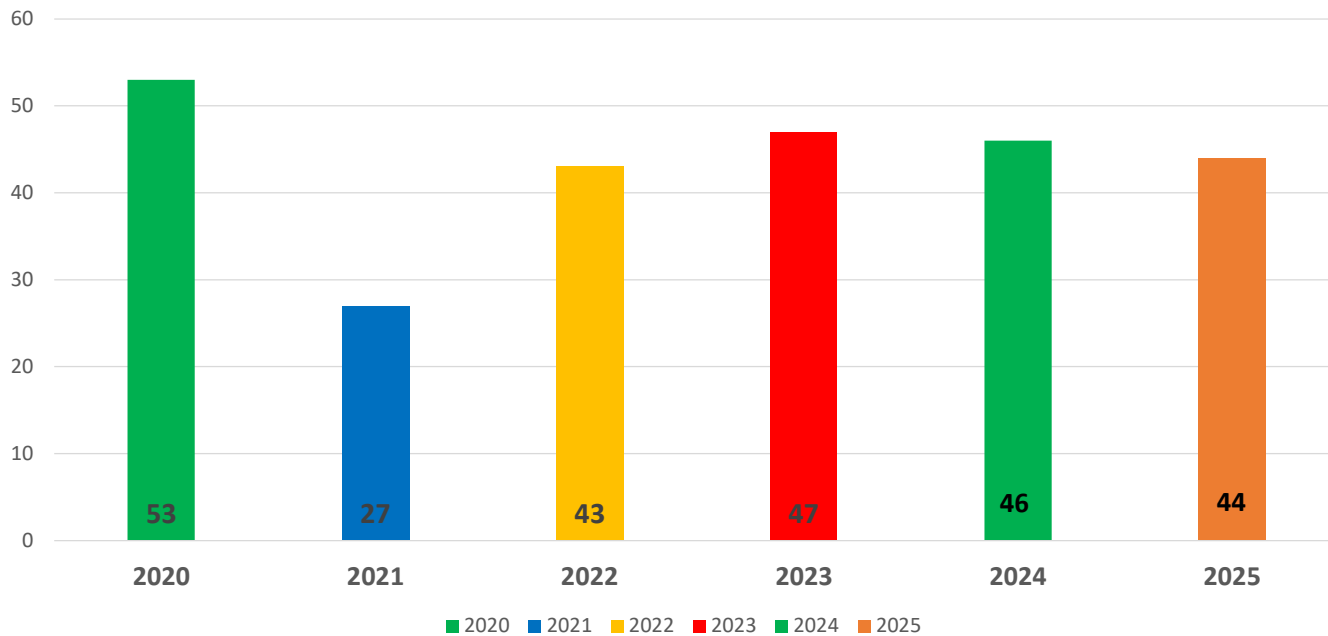

- ✓ Girl Brackets for local tournaments will be in Madison weights (State Events will stay with predetermined weights)
- ✓ PIN ratings will be used to seed Open tournaments as well as State Events. (All RR are 100% and all other brackets will be seeded 50% up to 8)
- ✓ There will be a \$5 discount on registration for local tournaments if wrestlers are registered before the last 24 hours of registration

Proposal #1 Bylaws changes

The Team Georgia board requests to make the following changes to the bylaws to keep the bylaws in line with the current wrestling needs.

Old:

4.4.2. Birth Date Certification - Upon request, each individual registering with the corporation must provide a legally registered document which proves date of birth.

New: Add Residency requirements

4.4.2 Birth Date Certification/Residency - Upon request, each individual registering with the corporation must provide a legally registered document which proves date of birth. Upon request, each individual registering with the corporation must provide report card, utility bill, lease or deed.

Old:

6.1. G. A. W. A. Divisions – G.A.W.A. shall establish divisions within itself in order to operate quickly and efficiently to most effectively meet the needs of the members of the corporation. These divisions of the corporation shall function as operational arms and are under the jurisdiction of G. A. W. A. The divisions recognized by the corporation shall include but not be limited to Kids, Cadets, Juniors, Open, Women, Officials, Pairing, Duals, Education and Communication.

New: Remove list of positions

6.1. G. A. W. A. Divisions – G.A.W.A. shall establish divisions within itself in order to operate quickly and efficiently to most effectively meet the needs of the members of the corporation. These divisions of the corporation shall function as operational arms and are under the jurisdiction of G. A. W. A. The divisions recognized by the corporation shall include but not be limited to the positions listed in 6.3

Proposed change to the Qualifications for Kids State.

Current format:

Qualifying for Kids State

This year, the following requirements will be strictly enforced in order to attend Kids State.

1. Must have a valid USA Wrestling Card.
2. Must be a Georgia Resident to participate.
3. Cannot be in High School (9th thru 12th Grade) even if age eligible. Must be 14U or below regardless of grade.

4. **MUST PLACE 1-4 AT ONE OF THE TEAM GEORGIA QUALIFIERS.**

5. If a qualifier only has 3 qualifiers, we will pick up the 4th spot from the 5th placer at the largest qualifier. So, if Qualifier A only has 3 kids in a bracket. All 3 will qualify, you must weigh in. However, there is a spot open in the bracket. The 5th placer from the largest qualifier will then qualify.

Proposed change to Section 5:

5. If a qualifier only has 3 qualifiers, we will pick up the 4th spot from the 5th placer at the largest qualifier. So, if Qualifier A only has 3 kids in a bracket. All 3 will qualify, you must weigh in. However, there is a spot open in the bracket. The 5th placer from the largest qualifier will then qualify.

In the event where there are 16 or less wrestlers in a weight class throughout the State, all wrestlers from that weight class will be pulled into the Kids State Tournament in order to fill out the 16 man bracket. Wrestlers will still be required to qualify for Kids State at the Kids State Qualifiers and will be required to weigh in and compete for their qualification to be valid.

Wrestlers who are the only wrestlers in their respective weight classes at a Qualifier are required to make weight at the Qualifier to qualify for Kids State.
