

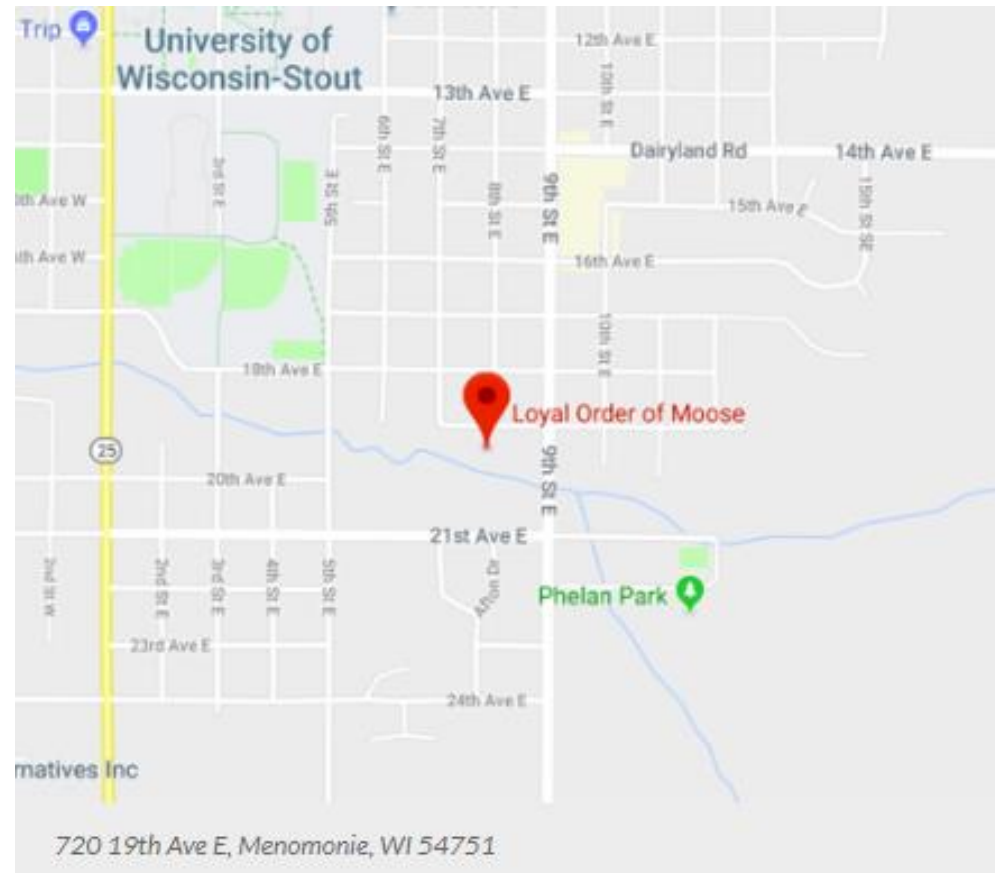

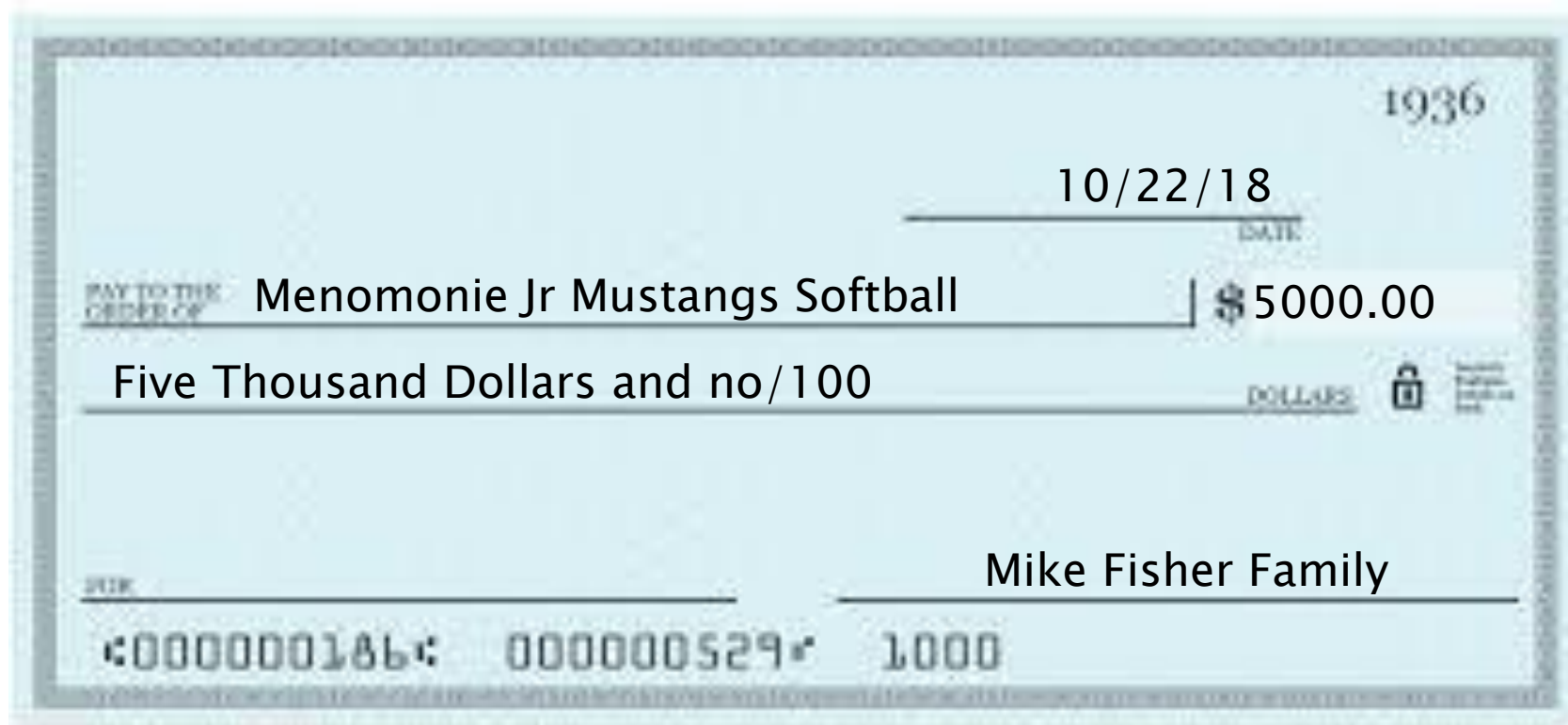



Mission

- ▶ The mission of the Menomonie Jr Mustangs Softball Program is to mold our teams into not only great athletes, but also great youth women. Our travel program is geared for those players who wish to regularly compete at a higher level of competition. It is also our goal to help create fun memories that will last these young women throughout their life!
- 

Recreation Ball

- ▶ Girls from K – 12th grade (8U, 10U, 12U, 14U, HS) are eligible for this program
- ▶ This program is designed to develop the total individual, not just the athlete. The Rec Program emphasizes equal playing time for all participants.
 - Focus is on teaching the game of softball, skill development, hard work, teamwork and good sportsmanship.
- ▶ Games played in surrounding communities – Seymour Ball Club League
- ▶ No Evaluation, all girls play & rotate positions
- ▶ Season runs from Mid-March to Mid-June
- ▶ This program is ran through the Rec Department
- ▶ Requests for car-pooling and playing will be considered but there are no guarantees.
- ▶ Cost: \$56 City Resident or \$74 Non-City Resident.

Travel Ball players are not recommended to play Rec. Softball as Travel Ball practices and games will be during the week and weekend

Travel Softball

- ▶ 8U, 10U, 12U, 14U team currently (Goal of 16U & 18U teams)
- ▶ Geared towards Menomonie community players who wish to regularly compete at a higher level
- ▶ Evaluations for teams
 - Goal is to NOT cut any players (committee has numerous ideas around this)
 - A and B teams at levels with multiple teams
- ▶ Play 8–12 in-house scrimmages and 4–6 tournaments
 - In-House scrimmages would be split home and away
 - Including a minimum of 1 night under the lights scrimmage
- ▶ Commitment is required!!
 - The scheduling team/coaches are also committed to providing a list of tournaments early in the season
- ▶ This program is run by the Menomonie Jr Mustang Softball Program
- ▶ Cost: \$250 (10U and up) plus volunteer 10 hours per player
 - All 8U players will play Rec Ball + \$50 to play in 2–3 tournaments
 - We need help...so buyout is not an option

Evaluation Details

- ▶ Sunday, January 27th @ UW Stout
- ▶ A skills evaluation process determines placement
- ▶ A selection committee appointed by the softball committee will conduct the player evaluation
 - Likely be made up of players from the UW–Stout Softball team.
 - Any person who has a daughter trying out for the particular age group being evaluated cannot be involved in the age evaluation.
- ▶ Goal for Fall Evaluations moving forward


