Field Use Protocols: Harbor Links

- Team Responsibilities Each Team is responsible for all participants from their Team using this facility and must ensure that
 their Team abides by these Field Use Protocols as well as all LIJSL, NYCL and NY State Guidelines. Failure to abide by these
 protocols may result in removal from this facility.
- Max Supporters Allowed per Team We request that a maximum of one (1) supporter for each player attend, but will allow a
 maximum of two (2) supporters per player in accordance with <u>Reopening</u> New York State Sports and Recreation mandatory
 physical distancing requirements


Entering/Exiting the Fields

- **Pre-Match:** Teams should NOT enter the facility until 30 minutes prior to their match and may not entering the playing field area, or take a position on the touchlines (soccer sidelines), until AFTER the prior match is completed AND the teams, players, coaches and spectators have left.
- Accessing Fields #1 & #2 Use the West staircase on Field #1 to enter the field and the East staircase on Field #1 to leave the field. Designated player/spectator locations at the field are denoted on the Field Map slide.
- Accessing Fields #3 & #4 Go through the golf club entrance, past the miniature golf course and up the hill to access the gate to the field (use the same gate to exit the filed). Be sure to stay to the right when entering/exiting the gate. Designated player/spectator locations at the field are denoted on the Field Map slide.

Masks/Face Coverings

- Players/Coaches/Trainers/Parent Managers A mask/face covering MUST BE WORN from the time you leave your
 vehicle until you reach your designated location at the field (please see field map for designated Home/Away Player
 locations for each field). Coaches/Trainers/Parent Managers must continue to wear masks/face coverings when not
 actively instructing and not a minimum of 6-feet from any other coach, player or referee. Post-match, a mask/face covering
 MUST BE WORN from the time you leave your designated location at the field until you enter your vehicle.
- Spectators i.e. Parents/Guardians Field Access A mask/face covering MUST BE WORN from the time you leave your car to access the field until the time you return to your car at the conclusion of the game.

Sideline Protocols: Harbor Links



- HOME team coaches, players AND spectators MUST BE on the SAME side (see field map for specific locations)
 - HOME team players and coaches take a position minimum of ten (10) feet from the touchline to the left of the midfield line. If a 3-referee system is used, this will be behind AR1
 - HOME team spectators may take a position a minimum of ten (10) feet on the other side of midfield, and ten (10) feet off the touchline within Spectator Area.
- VISITING team coaches, players AND spectators MUST BE on the OPPOSITE side (see field map for specific locations)
 - VISITING team players and coaches take a position minimum of ten (10) feet from the touchline to the left of the midfield line. If a 3-referee system is used, this will be behind AR2
 - VISITING team spectators may take a position a minimum of ten (10) feet on the other side of midfield, and ten (10) feet off the touchline within Spectator Area.

In-Match Protocols: Harbor Links

All participants; Players, Coaches, Spectators and Referees follow:

- Reopening New York State Sports and Recreation Summary Guidance
- US Soccer Play On Phase 3 Grassroots Soccer Recommendation Guide
- ENYYSA Game Day Protocols
- · New York State Sports and Recreation Master Guidance

This includes:

- Players, Coaches maintain minimum of 6 feet of physical distance from all others when on bench (players, coaches, etc.)
- When minimum of 6 feet of physical distance is not possible, wear face covering

Who Monitors

- · Referees Monitor ON-Field protocols
- BOTH Coaches Monitor OFF-The-Field protocols
- Referee addresses issues of safety to Responsible Party (HOME team Field Marshal, Safety Officer or Coach)
- Issues of compliance with facility protocols fall to Responsible Party
- Failure of either Team, Home or Visitors may result in match being terminated, potential forfeit to offending Team as determined by League

Post-Match Protocols: Harbor Links

At completion of match:

- NO handshakes between players, coaches as well as referees
- Players & Coaches should acknowledge opposing teams and referee(s); clapping, thumbs-up
- Teams and spectator immediately gather personal belongings, equipment and with face coverings on, leave immediate field area. NO post-match discussions there.
