## Meeting Minutes for November 2020 Moses Lake Youth Hockey Association Location: 420 W Broadway Ave, Moses Lake, WA

Date of Meeting: November 10, 2020

Meeting called to order at 5:40pm

Melanie made motion to accept October minutes with no corrections. Bob second.

The city is currently waiting for State approval for public skate. This could mean more ice time for MLYHA. The practice schedule has been sent to Tom Los as requested.

Melanie reported some payment requests had been made for reimbursement of referee fees. Board agreed that all needs to be completed and Crest needs to be obtained before getting paid from MLYHA. This goes for coach reimbursement as well.

Mention was made of incentives for youth players to referee. Example: \$100 worth of gear. Discussion around the fact that it is hard to schedule youth referees due to game schedule.

Melanie reported the ending balance as of October 31, 2020 as \$29,828.41

Chad reported coaches were all set for all teams. He may have a coaches' meeting the very first Saturday of practice. There would be evaluations for any new players.

There are no games scheduled so far. No other association is scheduling either.

Registration fees are not due until December 1st. Due to the uncertainty of the season still, decided the fee would remain at \$525 and we would reevaluate rebates or refunds at the end of the season. There is a potential for lots of extra ice time.

Discussion of the request from OT Hockey for ice time and registering through MLYHA. Concern regarding time involvement for Courtney (registrar for MLYHA) and concern over ice time if the City is able to have public skate and we end up having games. Board came up with guidelines and will pass them onto Ryan.

- Courtney to check with Jeremy McCann regarding OT Hockey being able to roster their own players for the season and for all games and tournaments they are playing.
- OT Hockey would pay MLYHA \$525 per registered player.
- OT Hockey recieves up to four hours per weekend at Moses Lake rink. Sundays, anytime between 8-1pm and possibly Saturday, anytime between 3-8pm (if approved by City and no public skate) or between 8-10pm after public skate. OT Hockey would be responsible for those four hours regardless of use.
