This document is for CCGSA only and is in additional to all requirements for USA Softball and is for CCGSA. This document will be used during the respectful season listed above as expectations and guidance provided to coaches.

Coaches will:

- Only allow USA background certified assistance coaches or parents in the dugout or on the field during
 practices/games. If a player or a coach is not USA certified all games may be forfeited and no refunds will
 be issued. (Bottomline, this has to be done as this is a huge risk to ensure safe play).
- Ensure their Players and Parents are provided and follow the CCGSA Player & Parent Code of Conduct and held to those standards.
- Set the best example possible for all of my players, parents, and fans.
- Be responsible to ensure their parents/fans act appropriately or will have them leave the park.
- Ensure umpires are treated respectfully by assistant coaches, parents, players, fans, and themselves.
- Do their best to ensure each player has a great season.
- Let the CCGSA Board know if anything happens during their practices or at games that causes concern or needs reviewed by an association board member or a CCGSA board member.

Violation of any USA Softball or CCGSA rules including the <u>USA Code of Ethics</u> or the <u>CCGSA Coaches Code of Ethics</u> agreement may cause a Coach or parent to be removed from the coaching staff and games. Your team may be required to forfeit all remaining games. No refunds will be issued.
