Pastor's Message

As we mark the fulfillment of the Christmas season, with the arrival of the Wisemen at the home of the Holy Family, so we bless our homes with chalk, praying for all who dwell in them and those who will be welcomed.

We reflect upon the three-fold gifts of this season: (1) the gift of God the Father sending His Son, Jesus, (2) the gifts of gold [kingship], frankincense [divinity], and myrrh [death], and (3) the gifts that we have given and received mirroring the gifts of God the Father and the Wisemen.

During the Christmas season, we have been using incense as a reminder of the humble babe in a manger who is also the Son of God, uniting two natures in Christ, that of God and man.

Prayer for the Blessing of Homes on the Feast of Epiphany

Bless, O Lord God almighty, this home, that in it there may be health, purity, the strength of victory, humility, goodness and mercy, the fulfillment of Thy law, the thanksgiving to God the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. And may this blessing remain upon this home and upon all who dwell herein. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Then with chalk, inscribe on the outside door **20 + C + M + B + 24** (The year 2024 with the names of the Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar).

Saint of the Week

When Andre' Bessette came to the Holy Cross Brothers in 1870, he carried with him a note from his pastor saying, "I am sending you a saint."

The Brothers found that difficult to believe. Health issues made it impossible for Andre' to keep a job or get an education. At the age of 25, Andre' still did not know how to read and write. It seemed as if Andre' approached the religious order because there was nowhere else for him to go. The Brothers soon discovered that Andre' was prayerful and deeply devoted to God and Saint Joseph. He may have had no place left to go, but he believed that was because this was the place he felt he should have been all along.

After Andre' took his vows, he dedicated himself to small tasks, tending the door and giving hair cuts. Guided by his devotion to Saint Joseph, he saved what small earnings he had to build a church! Starting with a small wooden chapel and continuing to get permission from his Archbishop to continue to build, until, after his death, a great basilica was completed in honor of Saint Joseph.

Saint Andre' Bessette reminds us that when we serve other's through God's love, even small acts can be great!

MASS INTENTIONS

A Mass Intention is a person's request for the Mass to be prayed for particular individual(s) living or deceased.

*Church law requires all priests to fulfill all Mass Stipends within one calendar year. Any Mass Intentions not fulfilled within the year must be forwarded to priests at our local Seminary, or to other priests in our diocese.

Due to the large number of requests for Mass Intentions at Crucifixion, we find it necessary to limit requests to **3 per person**, with one being on a weekend. One Mass each weekend must be offered for the intentions of all parishioners, so this limits the number available for scheduling others.

Our Crucifixion calendar is now full through April 2024. Please note that weekday intentions may be rescheduled due to funerals, or Mass schedule changes.

Our aim is to meet your requests in a timely fashion and to open the calendar in a fair and consistent way so as to provide a shorter waiting period for Masses.
