


CR1 Entry Procedure

It is CR1's intentions to get as many CR1 athletes into our races as possible. There may be circumstances in which out of CR or Division athletes are selected before CR1 athletes.

US Ski and Snowboard Athlete Event Registration will be used for all races.

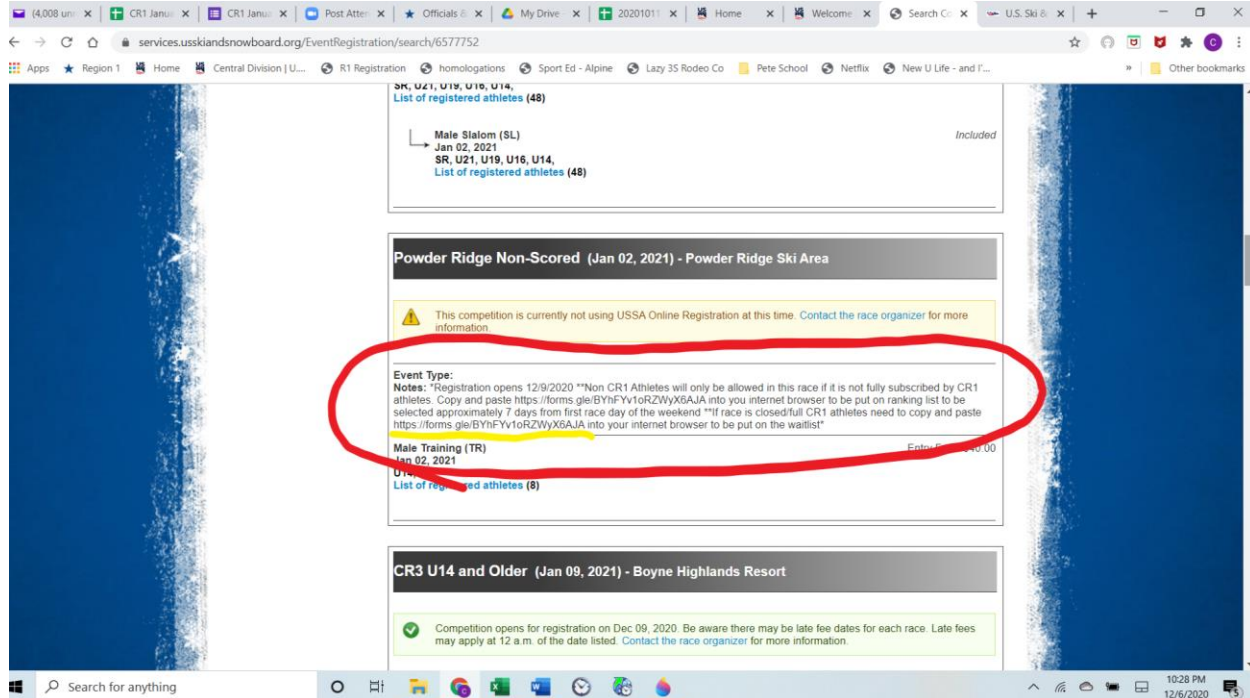
PROGRAMS NEED TO SHARE WITH PARENTS AND ATHLETES THE IMPORTANCE TO NOT SIGN UP FOR RACE JUST TO HAVE A SPOT. Because there are more athletes than spots, anyone that signs up “just in case we might go” will be taking a spot from someone who really wants to go. If you are unable to attend and have registered, you **MUST** contact the CR1 office at cussa_region1@yahoo.com so the next alternate has the opportunity to attend.

NON-SCORED and SCORED RACES

No more than 100 athletes can race at one ski area in any given day per US Ski and Snowboard COVID restrictions

1. Registration for all races will be opened in stages throughout the year
 - a. Races in the first 2 weekends of January 2021 will open December 9, 2020
 - b. Races in the second 3 weekends of January 2021 will open December 15, 2020
 - c. Races in the first 2 weekends of February 2021 will open January 1, 2021
 - d. Races in the second 2 weekends of February 2021 will open January 15, 2021
 - e. Races in the first 2 weekends of March 2021 will open February 1, 2021
 - f. Races in the second 2 weeks of March 2021 will open February 15, 2021
2. US Ski and Snowboard registration for CR1 athletes will be on a first come, first serve basis

3. 90% of spots per race will be available through the US Ski and Snowboard registration portal until it fills and closes or 10 days at 1:01am CST before the first race day of the weekend.
4. If a race fills to 90% and there are athletes that still want to register, a Google Waitlist form will be linked to all registrations to create a waiting list.



- a. This Waitlist form will be timed stamped. The time stamp will be the order of which eligible athletes will be selected to be added to the race.
 - b. This Waitlist form will be open to CR1 athletes ONLY from the time the US Ski and Snowboard Athlete Event Registration closes up until 12:00pm CST 7 days prior to the first race of the weekend. Waitlist submittals outside this window are not considered.
 - c. We will begin notifying racers as soon as possible after the waitlist closes.
5. Out of CR1 athletes wanting to race in CR1 US Ski and Snowboard races are be asked to always use the Waitlist form up until 12:00pm CST 7 days before the first day of the race weekend instead of using the US Ski and Snowboard Athlete Event Registration.
 - a. Per the Central Rulebook, athletes wishing to race outside their home CR must get permission from the President of the CR hosting the race. This policy is the reference used.
 - b. Non CR1 Athletes will only be allowed in a CR1 race if it is not fully subscribed by CR1 athletes.
 - c. Athletes will be informed as soon as possible after the Waitlist form is closed and prioritized.
 - d. Scored Race – Out of CR1 athletes will be ranked by the US Ski and Snowboard points in the event(s) being contested; ties will be put in order of timestamp.
 - e. Non-Score Race – Out of CR1 athletes will be put in order of their time stamp on the Google form.

6. Out of Division athletes wanting to race in CR1 US Ski and Snowboard races will use the current system in place through Regional Directors and Divisional Managers directing them to the ROC policy. This policy is the reference used.
 - a. Non CR1 Athletes will only be allowed in a CR1 race if it is not fully subscribed by CR1 athletes.
7. CR1 Board of Directors reserves the right to use up to five of the available Waitlist spots per race for discretion. The Executive Committee will handle any discretionary requests.
