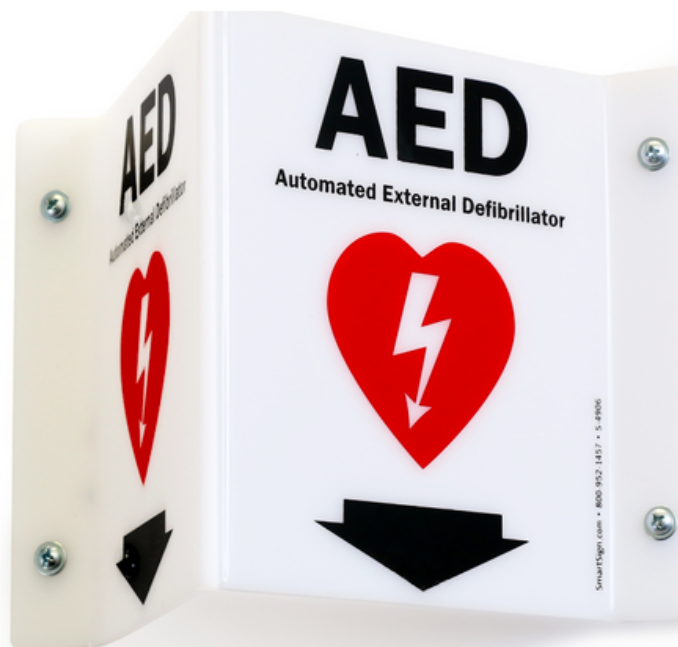
SAFETY FIRST

Did you know that we have an AED at Thornton Park? It is currently located inside the women's restroom which is unlocked during practice and game times. LMYFC is also working to arrange discounted CPR training classes that will be voluntary as long as at least two members of staff per team are CPR certified. LMYFC is committed to ensuring our coaches have the resources they need to provide a fun but safe season.
