

Farmington Tiger Bands Booster Meeting Minutes 9/20/17

1. Tami called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.
2. Meeting minutes: Rochelle motioned to approve meeting minutes from 8/16/17. Bill seconded. Motion passed.
3. Treasurer's report: We have \$27,063.35 in our account. Our most recent purchase is the trailer (\$5,000 plus another \$96 for a few other items for trailer)
4. Director's Report:
 - a. State Fair-Awesome day; took 1st for the day and 6th overall.
 - b. Empire-Great crowd; everything went well.
 - c. Rosemount-Took 3rd and got the Spirit Award.
5. TFC Report:
 - a. Big Brain Bash-18 teams; \$7,500 made for TFC.
 - b. Profit for band boosters from last year concessions is \$1731.79
6. Communication: Please make sure to copy Tami and Sue D. on any band booster e-mails.
7. Marching Band:
 - a. Props-\$3,000 was budgeted for this year's props; only \$1,800 was used. It was discussed that eventually we see the need to know the show idea sooner to plan accordingly for prop ideas/budget.
 - b. Money leftover from band camp will be used for an evening meal for students at YIM.
 - c. YIM: It was decided that we will need 14 volunteers for the field prep, 6 volunteers for loading/unloading the trailer, and 8 chaperones. Farmington performs at 10:00am.
 - d. Volunteers: It was discussed that we could still use several more volunteers for uniforms and to help with props on the field. Having instructions for volunteers would make things go smoothly.
8. Fundraising:
 - a. We have several tumblers and water bottles left; hoping to see more at the band brunch.
 - b. Heggies sales are from 9/11-9/25. Volunteers will be meeting to count orders on 9/26 at 6:00pm. Delivery is 10/16. Orders need to be picked up between 5:00-6:00pm.
 - c. 30th Annual Band Brunch is scheduled for 11/5. Each family is asked to make a \$10 donation for food. (\$11 if donating online) About 35 donations have come in so far. Volunteers positions will be filled through Sign UP Genius. It was decided that volunteers should hand patrons their plate after they give them their ticket to avoid confusion. Tami will let us know when ticket sales begin.
 - d. Poinsettia Sale kick-off is 10/2. Need to turn in forms by 10/30. Delivery will be 11/17.
 - e. Mattress Sale-Dori is the booster contact person for this fundraiser. More information will be available soon.
9. Other:
 - a. A wrap for the newly purchased trailer would cost \$3,000 for 4 sides. Once we send in a design we could have one within 3 days. We could sell advertising space on the trailer for \$1,000-2,000.
 - b. Sue Condon brought up the idea of purchasing flags for the color guard to use during the parades with Farmington colors/logo, to represent the school district. No decision was made at this time.

11. Upcoming Meetings: 10/17, 11/18, no meeting in December, 1/16, 2/20.
