THE HISTORY

LEAVING IT BETTER THAN THEY FOUND IT!

Over the years the Farmington High School Girls Hockey team has had an ample amount of success. The on-ice success is apparent when looking around Schmitz-Maki Arena and seeing all the State Tournament appearances, Conference Championship Banners and even an Academic State Championship title. Take a peek behind the bleachers and you will see a photo area littered with girls' alumni that have gone on to play Division 1 and Division 3 college hockey.

The off-ice success however is what really drives the team to try and make gains and leave places better than they found them each year. The Tiger Tone has long been a part of the team's core values and beliefs on how to approach hockey and life. With the team having only two head coaches in its existence there has been a consistent message to the players and families to "live and play hockey with integrity."

The program's first head coach was Tiger Alumni Keith Revels. Revels started the official High School program in 1995-1996. He had the helm for the team's entire existence in the class A days. He built a powerhouse and made a name that has forever connected Minnesota Girls Hockey with Farmington Girls Hockey. Revels had three state tournament appearances. In 2007 the team was handed off to another Tiger Alumni and Athlete of the year, when Jon Holmes took over. Holmes has had the team through the present and has led the Tigers to four state tournament appearances, three conference championships, and has been the coach for Farmington's entire existence in the class AA and South Suburban Conference world.

Being dependable and consistent is a shared message from both Coach Holmes and Coach Revels throughout the years. Knowing when you are on the ice you are responsible for all of the other players hopes and dreams is a concept the team does not take lightly. Knowing this will prepare them to have others depend on them later in life and taking their individual talents and interlacing them with a larger team and community is what Farmington Girls Hockey is all about.

Aside from the dependability and consistency of only two head coaches, the ultimate consistency has been vested in Amy Pietsch. Amy has been the team's manager since its inception in 1995. She doesn't miss a game and she doesn't miss an opportunity to give back to the community and the program in a way that is unmatched! She even has one more year of service to the program than longtime assistant coach Jason Kohlblbeck!
