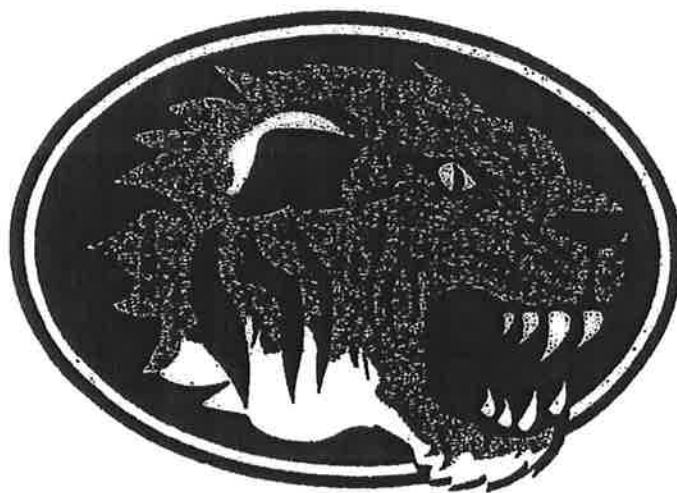

## Junior Varsity Overview

The junior varsity team had an outstanding season. The wrestlers should be very proud of the level of dedication and hard work they displayed throughout the season. Our coaching staff is very excited about the amount of depth our program has developed over the years. The number of experienced wrestlers we continue to get fed each year from our two middle schools and EWC allows us to be very competitive at all three levels. This year's team like many before it consisted of many skilled grapplers that would be varsity at many other metro area schools.

This year's team had a dual meet record of 20-0, another very impressive season for a team that was very different from week to week throughout the season due to depth and a few injuries. The team competed in three tournaments this season: Mehlville Dual Team Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> Place), Chatham Glenwood Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> Place), and the Southwest Conference JV Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> Place).

The team traveled across the river to Mehlville High School during Christmas break to compete in their always competitive dual team tournament. This tournament is always a great test for our teams as they wrestle five duals in one day against some of the better programs in the St. Louis area. The team competed extremely hard with one weight class open all day and a number of new guys in the lineup because of injuries and mid season growth from a few of our regulars. The team went 3-0 in pool action defeating Kirkwood, Herculaneum, and DeSoto.. This set up a semi final matchup against a very sound Rockwood Summit team. We dominated the upper weights and won the dual 50-30. The championship match was against a very good Eureka team that we needed everyone to wrestle their best to have a chance and even that might not have been enough forfeiting a weight class. The boys competed very hard keeping matches close and getting bonus points at weight classes we needed to and allowing us to capture our first **TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP** of the season with a 39-36 victory.

At the Chatham Glenwood Tournament we dominated the twenty-one team competition scoring 274.5 points, sixty points more than the second place team. The team placed in the top three in each weight class except for one. The team came out very strong not losing a single match until the semi finals with many victories coming by pin. At the end of the day the Tigers had seven individual champions, two runner-ups, three third place finishes and a **TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP**.

The JV season was coming to an end with one last goal to obtain that we take great pride in and that is defending our streak of JV Conference Championships. The tournament started with us matched up with a very athletic East St. Louis team that we defeated 54-15 in the first round of pool action showing great technique. Round two had the team faced up with a very well coached Alton team and the boys showed no mercy by defeating them 69-6. In the championship round the team showed great mental/physical toughness to beat a solid Belleville East team 54-18 and capture the **TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP**. As for individual accomplishments the team had nine qualify for the finals with four of them being crowned Conference Champions and two others placing third and fourth.

I would like to thank the parents of all the wrestlers for supporting your sons in competing this year in our program. Without your support it would be very difficult to be the team and program we are today. We appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and helping mold them into great young men of character on and off the mat.


